### Grow Closer to Jesus through Jubilee 2025

The **Jubilee Year of Hope** is underway. It is a time to experience God's mercy, seek forgiveness, and embrace God's presence in our lives.

Pope Francis began the Jubilee Year on Christmas Eve, opening the Holy Door of Saint Peter's Basilica in Rome. Four days later, **Bishop David Zubik** celebrated the opening Mass of Jubilee 2025 as the diocesan Jubilee Cross was carried into Saint Paul Cathedral in Pittsburgh.



The Jubilee Year is an opportunity to **restore hope and trust**, and be a sign of hope for those experiencing difficulties.

It is also an invitation to take part in a **pilgrimage**. Many pilgrims will visit Rome, but there are six churches in the Diocese of Pittsburgh where you can make a **pious visit** to obtain the **Jubilee Year Plenary Indulgence**. This full indulgence removes all temporal punishment for sins that have already been forgiven.

## Getting Ready for Lent

There will be a morning of recollection for all parishioners on **Saturday, March 1** from 8:30 - 11:30 am at Holy Redeemer Church as we prepare for the Lenten Season. Prayers will be recited in the church at 8:30 am followed by 9:00 am Mass. We will then proceed to the Catholic Center for my presentation entitled "The Spirit of the Lord is Upon Me." Complimentary breakfast is provided.

## Jubilee Year of Hope

Pope Francis has created the Jubilee Year of Hope for Catholics around the world. A "jubilee" began as an ancient tradition among the Jewish people as noted throughout the Old Testament to celebrate reconciliation, pilgrimage, and a coming home. Pope Francis has invited Catholics to Rome throughout 2025 to pass through the Holy Doors of the Roman basilicas. However, since most people will not be able to visit Italy each Bishop can designate places in their dioceses for pilgrimages.

Bishop Zubik has named six churches as pilgrimage sites: **Saint Paul Cathedral** (Allegheny County); Saint Augustine Parish, **Saint Monica Church** (Beaver County); All Saints Parish, **Saint Peter Church** (Butler County); Saint Matthias Parish, **Saint Ann Church** (Greene County); Holy Spirit Parish, **Saint Mary Church** (Lawrence County); and Saint James Parish, **Immaculate Conception Church** (Washington County). Pilgrims who visit any of these churches can gain an indulgence with the following conditions: detachment from all venial and mortal sins; going to confession, receiving Holy Communion, and praying for the intentions of Pope Francis. These can be fulfilled a few days before or after visiting the churches. A single confession is sufficient if you are visiting more than one of the churches; however, receiving Communion and praying for the Pope must be done for each indulgence. Prayers for the Holy Father can be as easy as offering an Our Father and Hail Mary.

Ordinary jubilees occur every 25 years in the Catholic Church. The last one was in 2000 which celebrated the 2000th anniversary of the birth of Christ and the start of the new millennium. This jubilee offers hope in the midst of human suffering due to the ongoing impact of war, COVID, and natural disasters. The Church's mission is to bring the hope of Jesus Christ, His Gospel, the Sacraments, the Word of God, and the mercy which God desires for us.



## **Unpacking the Word**


### **Jeremiah 17:5-8**

More than any other biblical figure, the Prophet Jeremiah's life and ministry anticipated the life and ministry of Jesus. Both were celibate prophets who experienced intense persecution from religious and civic leaders for their message of repentance and covenant renewal. Jeremiah was even "buried" in a well before being raised up out of it (see Jeremiah 37:16-21). It is little wonder that many people in Jesus' day thought he might be the return of Jeremiah (see Matthew 16:13-14). Our first reading and Gospel this week highlight the similarities in the content of their preaching, especially as it relates to blessings and curses.

Jeremiah taps into Israel's wisdom tradition with a clear allusion to Psalm 1 and its description of the righteous man as a tree planted beside a stream. He is also directly calling to mind the dynamics of the covenant in which there are blessings for fidelity to one's oath and curses for breaking it. God's people had sworn a covenant with him at Mt. Sinai after the Exodus and renewed it several times over, promising to rely solely upon the Lord. Jeremiah reminds the Kingdom of Judah and us that relying solely on human ingenuity, effort, and ability is as fruitful as "a barren bush in the desert." When we rely on the Lord, our "leaves" will stay green in the heat and we will "still bear fruit" even in a drought.


The blessings that Jeremiah describes depend upon trusting the Lord. Trust is the firm belief in the reliability, truthfulness, ability, and strength of someone else. It is, in a word, faith. Amid the storms of life and the droughts we all face, the Lord encourages us to stretch out our roots to the source of living water so that we can experience the flourishing that he intends for us.










