PASTOR'S NOTE

We are looking forward to the arrival of Fr. Jacob Willig in Oxford on July 1. I have heard from a number of parishioners congratulating me on "finally getting some help." I thought it would be best to clarify the situation to prevent confusion.

Fr. Jacob is not appointed as a parochial vicar (assistant) to me or to the parish. Though he will be living in the rectory as a guest of the parish, his primary responsibility is to the Newman Center/Catholic Campus Ministry. Father will have his office in the parish center which will become the center for campus ministry. He will set his own Mass and confession schedule separate from our parish schedule. Students will always be welcome in the church for Mass and sacraments, and year-round Oxford Catholics and neighbors will be welcome at Masses in the center.

The Archbishop and Fr. Willig have decided that administration, budget, staffing and other concerns regarding campus ministry will be solely Fr. Willig's responsibility. Beginning July 1st the parish office will no longer be the point of contact for campus ministry programs.

We will share any contact and scheduling information as soon as they become available. It is my every wish and hope that collaborations and cordiality will mark us as good neighbors.

Currently, I plan on keeping our schedule (newly restored after the end of covid restrictions have been lifted) as it is. Restructuring the use of facilities will take time, but I believe both organizations—parish and Newman Center—can co-exist and grow together in mutual respect.
