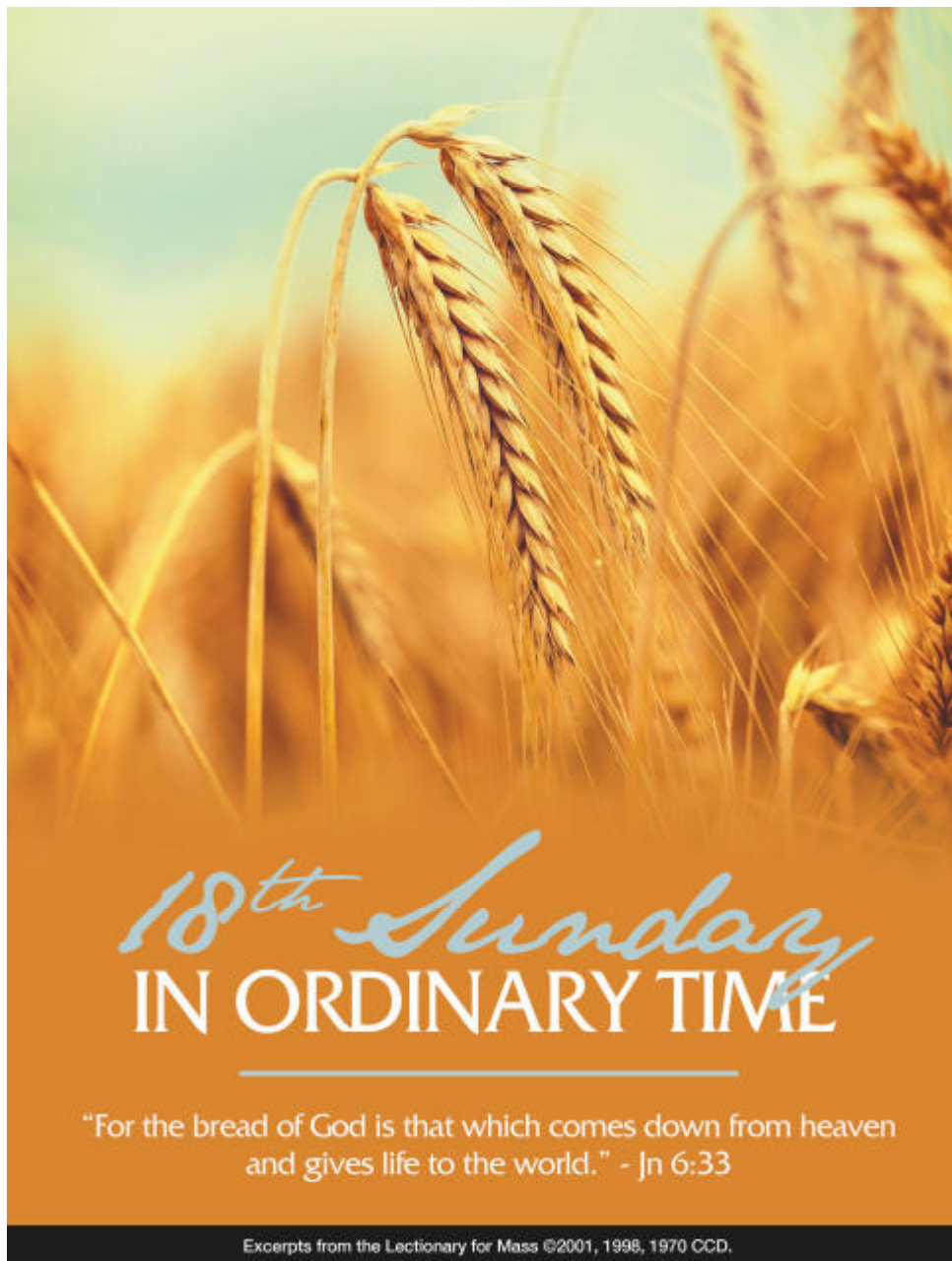

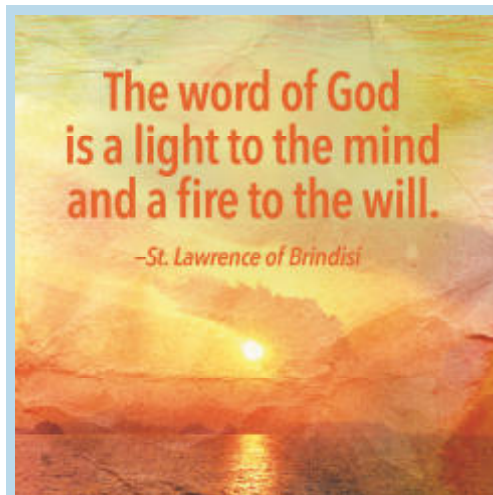

Changes to Uptown Parking

New smart meters and pay stations are being installed uptown. Smart meters take both coins and credit cards. The process will take a couple weeks. Enforcement efforts at the meters will resume August 2, 2021. Rates at many meters will change, up to \$1/hour, and hours

of operation have been extended to 8 p.m. Long term parkers should consider using Walnut Street or Church

Street where rates will remain at 25 cents per hour and you can park all day without moving. Consider downloading the Park-Mobile app, which is a convenient and contactless way to pay for your parking session with your phone. Remember, metered parking is in force for Saturday Mass and weekday holy days!
