The last in person session will be on Sunday, May 15 at the FFC. There will be an ice cream social after the 11:00 am mass on that Sunday in the Social Hall.


The last Family Faith Formation Sunday will be May 22 via zoom. This will be the last FF session of the year before summer break.




#### **Pontifical Good Friday Collection**

To act as a sponsor, you must be at least 16 years old, a practicing Catholic who has received Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. If married, it must be within the guidelines of the Catholic Church. Call and speak with any of the ladies in the office, our office hours are 10 AM - 3 PM.

#### <u>Baptisms</u>

By appointment only. Contact Katie Zuzik in the Parish Office at least three months in advance of the Baptism. A class for parents is required to reflect on the meaning of the sacrament, review the Ceremony and to highlight the importance of family commitment to practicing the Catholic Faith. 


