





LIVE THE LITURGY

Inspiration for the week

Prophets possess an intimate knowledge of God and act on their experience of God. Prophetic messages usually challenge the status quo and draw us up and out of ourselves, focusing us on the bigger picture. We often think of ourselves and our own needs first. When we listen to someone speak, we judge the merit of the message by its degree of usefulness. If the message or vision contains no personal benefit or profit but a call to stretch and grow, we can become indignant. Prophets are usually the ones whose message challenges us and calls us to see things differently and love more perfectly and deeply. God is love. When listening to St. Paul speak about love we witness the unfolding of this type of unconditional, other centered, self-sacrificial perfect God. It is an invitation to life, freedom, and happiness that can be offered to us only by God. Jesus, who is God and Love incarnate, calls us to this richer expression of love. Are we ready to listen and be challenged and stretched?



SAINT OF THE WEEK

You may be familiar with the annual "blessing of throats" that many parishes in the United States use to commemorate the beloved bishop and martyr. St. Blaise lived in the fourth century in Turkey and Armenia. Due to religious persecution, he was forced to flee and hide in a cave in the back country in order to save his life.

History has it that one day a group of hunters stumbled upon where St. Blaise was living. They found the bishop kneeling in prayer, surrounded by wolves, lions and bears that he had tamed. The legend has it that as the hunters dragged Blaise off to prison, a mother came with her young son who had a fish bone lodged in his throat. At Blaise's command, the child was able to cough up the bone and thus lived.

Today we remember the saint on his feast day by taking two candles, crossing them against the throat, and saying the following prayer:

Through the intercession of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from ailments of the throat and from every other evil. In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.



Parents and Guardians, please remember to keep your eyes on your inbox for Faith Formation information updates during the global pandemic. We ask for your continued patience and flexibility as we monitor evolving guidelines and mandates.



Special Needs and Traditional Sunday morning Faith Formation sessions meet this weekend at Saint Kilian! Please remember that masks are MANDATORY. Be sure that your child has his or her mask before leaving the house and prior to getting out of the car. Our programs rely on volunteers who serve as catechists, aides, substitutes, and mentors. Volunteer shortages any particular week may necessitate the cancellation of individual onsite classes on a case-by-case basis. Should your child's class be cancelled, you will be notified via Flocknote. These messages will include information about making up the session at home! ALWAYS check for messages prior to leaving the home on Sunday mornings. If a single class is cancelled due to a volunteer shortage, that does not mean that all classes have been cancelled. Please be attentive to the message specifics.



In the event of severe weather at any time during the Faith Formation year, please know that should classes need to be *cancelled* (they will never simply be delayed), you will be notified immediately when the decision is made via **Flocknote email** AND **text message**. As we move into the typically

more severe winter weather weeks and months that lie ahead, be sure that these communications are not blocked or directed to your spam or junk folder. Aways check for them in those folders prior to leaving home on Faith Formation days if the weather is questionable. Additionally, notification will be sent to local news agencies for broadcast, but Flocknote communications will be the most timely. Any cancellation will most likely result in needing to *make up the lesson at home with your child*. Stay safe!






