





Under the above banner, each week you will find information regarding our process of merging our two parishes into one canonical entity, a brand new parish. We are some of the very last parishes in the Diocese of Pittsburgh to undertake this process. On this page each week you will learn details of how this will take place and some of its implications. Please read it each week.

When we become one parish on July 1, 2023, all the buildings of both current parishes will be available for parish activities. Some way of accurately identifying them was needed. It seems best to begin with a general location identification. We will gradually begin to identify three locations: **The Mars Campus**, **The Glade Mills Campus**, **and The Cranberry Campus**. Various activities will be listed by these three identifiers. We realize that many may not be familiar with all the buildings on all the campuses. Therefore, today's bulletin and subsequent bulletins will describe those buildings, campus by campus. Below, is the Cranberry Campus.

THE CRANBERY CAMPUS

Parish Administrative and Education Center (School Building)



The first building to be built by Saint Kilian Parish in Cranberry Township, it was dedicated on December 8, 2010. It contains a chapel and gymnasium, a cafeteria and kitchen, a Pre-School classroom, 24 home rooms (K-8) as well as classrooms for special subjects, a library and meeting rooms as well as offices for the Parish and Catholic school.

Field Center and Maintenance Building

Adjacent to the soccer field there is a substantial building containing lavatories, a concessions area (with water and refrigeration) as well as storage for sports equipment. On the lower level, there is storage for maintenance equipment and vehicles.



Church

The 1,000-seat church was dedicated on September 25, 2016. In addition to the worship space the lower level contains two large meeting rooms, two offices, a substantial hall, and a full kitchen.



Rectory

The rectory dates from the early 1960's. It as well as adjacent land was purchased as plans for the first building began. The rectory was completely renovated by volunteer labor. It contains three bedrooms and three baths as well as a two car integral garage.



LIVE THE LITURGY

Inspiration for the week

Ultimately, what does God promise to give us when we pray? The short answer to that question is God. God promises to give Himself to us in prayer. Prayer is about union with God, not receiving favors. When God comes to us in prayer, His presence comes with faith, hope, and love. When we find these virtues enhanced and nurtured, we know that our prayer has been heard and answered. When we seek out, listen to, and live by these virtues we find ourselves led back to God and more united with the Divine Presence. We struggle with what we want God to do and how we want our prayer validated. That's what makes Jesus' prayer, the Our Father, so perfect. It celebrates a deepening intimate relationship of trust between our Creator and us. When we persistently cry out for God in love, how can that prayer go unanswered?



SAINT OF THE WEEK

Saint James the Apostle is also called James, son of Zebedee, or James the Greater to distinguish him from the other James in Jesus' group of twelve. Most of what we know about Saint James is recorded in the New Testament. He and his brother John were collected by Jesus along the sea of Galilee. Matthew 4:18-22 tells the story of Jesus calling first Simon Peter and his brother Andrew and then the sons of Zebedee. In Mark 3:17 the brothers receive a nickname from Jesus who calls them "sons of thunder" because of their many extreme reactions, like that in Luke 9:54 when they offer to call down fire on a Samaritan village.

Saint James was part of Jesus' intimate circle, a witness to the Transfiguration, the resurrection of Jarius' daughter, and the agony in the garden of Gethsemane. In A.D. 44 Herod Agrippa had "James, the brother of John, killed by the sword." (Acts 12:2) He is the only apostle whose martyrdom is written of in the New Testament.

According to Spanish tradition, his body was taken to Santiago de Compostela, Spain where his relics were rediscovered in 9th century. This tradition has sometimes been attributed to a passage in the Song of Roland which tells of St. James appearing to Charlemagne in a dream, prophesying that Charlemagne would conquer the Moors in Spain. This was followed by a vision of stars which if followed would lead to the saint's lost tomb. In the Middle Ages Compostela was a hugely popular pilgrimage site. The saint's relics continue to rest in the cathedral there and one can still undertake the pilgrimage.


