### The Liturgy—Work of the Holy Trinity

Christ’s work in the liturgy is sacramental: because his mystery of salvation is made present by the power of the Holy Spirit; because his Body, which is the Church, is like a sacrament (sign and instrument) in which the Holy Spirit dispenses the mystery of salvation; and because through her liturgical actions the pilgrim Church already participates as by a foretaste, in the heavenly liturgy. The mission of the Holy Spirit in the liturgy is to prepare the assembly to encounter Christ; to recall and manifest Christ to the faith of the assembly; to make the saving work of Christ present and active by his transforming power; and to make the gift of communion bear fruit in the Church.” Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1110-1112

My beloved sisters and brothers,

In the name of the Father, our Abba, and of the Son, Jesus Christ, our Lord, and in the name of the Holy Spirit, our Advocate and Guide. Amen.

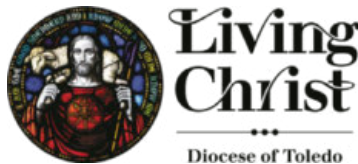
Ordinary Time within the liturgical year now resumes. Two great Feasts launch us into this longer season of the Church's liturgical calendar. The first is today's Feast of the Holy Trinity and next week is the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). These two Feasts make up the Cross: The Trinity is the vertical bar, and the Body and Blood of Christ is the horizontal bar.

On this Feast, we reflect the mystery of the three persons: One God in reality. Our reflection is not about trying to figure out what this mystery is, the who and the how, but rather to appreciate how these personas act on our behalf. The Father sent the Son to be united with humanity, to suffer with us, and then to redeem us. The Father and the Son sent the Holy Spirit to be with us always, guiding and sanctifying us. And so, we come together as the Church, to give praise, honor, and glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

### Rev. August Schaefer Endowment Fund



On July 1, 2022, The Rev. August Schaefer Endowment Fund will complete its 22nd year of awarding scholarships and grants within the St. Joseph Parish and Diocesan community. Since its inception over 150 parishioners have received a total of \$1,027,082 in scholarships. This year’s recipients of the Rev. August Schaefer Scholarship for continued education are Austin Bell, Kory Berhent, Gillian Borgio, Kaden Conrad, Kory Conrad, Anne Cook, Ryan Gwin, Emily Reineck, Paige Reineck, Alexzander Savona, Dylan Savona and Natalie Twarek.

St. Joseph Parish, itself, has received donations for various projects from the Rev. August Schaefer Endowment. Donations were given for the interior remodeling of our ministry center and the 2017 renovation of the interior of St. Joseph Church. Our boiler project, improvements to the church bells, live video streaming camera system, and roof work completed on the parish office and rectory were made possible because of the Schaefer endowment. We are very fortunate as this Endowment provided us with funds that would normally have been solicited from our parishioners to pay these expenses.

It is through the generosity of the Schaefer Endowment that the Diocesan Liturgical Grant recipients have received a total of \$586,627 through the years. This money has eased funding for many of our Diocesan parishes for their various liturgical needs.

We are honored to continue the financial support of the Adrian Dominican Sisters after their presence and assistance in our community for many years. Since 2008 they have received a total of \$30,000 from The Endowment.

The current Schaefer Endowment Trustees are Fr. Jim Brown, Barb Collins, Sue Hartman, Judy Indorf, Larry Indorf and Chris Twarek. Thank you to these men and women who help to administer these funds.

Father Schaefer must be so delighted that his legacy of giving is continuing. So many have benefited from his generosity. A total of \$1,783,003 has been given out over the last 22 years.
