





LITURGY SPOTLIGHT

Reverence for Communion and How Does it Take Place

Within the guidelines for the reception of Holy Communion, there is a new gesture that will take place. All who receive are to make an act of reverence. In the past, people have made a sign of reverence by genuflection, bow or a sign of the cross. The new GIRM states that all the faithful will receive communion standing and the act of reverence will be a bow of the head before receiving the consecrated host and drinking from the chalice. Care must be used so that we are not bowing to the back of the head of the person in front of us, but rather waiting until we are standing before the Eucharist. Keep in mind, that those conscious of mortal sin must make a good confession before going to Holy Communion; without confession there is the sin of sacrilege.


There will also be a 15-minute private meditation following the Mass.
