SECOND CHANCES

I remember in another parish where I had served that the choir had a beautiful choral piece that utilized the theme that our God is a God of second chances. That is an important theme to hold onto, especially when we are aware of some area or areas of our life where we have gotten off track. Our gracious and merciful God gives us the opportunity to try again!

We are reminded of this reality during the Season of Lent --- a season of repentance for sin and reforming of our life. Satan is at work to have our past sins and failings become a pit of hopeless discouragement. Why bother trying? Satan desires that we give up the fight and surrender to him. This is not the Spirit that Jesus brings to us.

Through the centuries we have had many examples of human frailty that have been turned into remarkable examples of spiritual triumph. St. Paul began as a persecutor of Christians but was given a second chance to become an ardent disciple of Christ. St. Peter denied Christ not once but three times but was given a second chance to be the rock upon which Christ chose to build His Church. St. Augustine was very wayward in his early years but became a wonderful scholar and promoter of the Catholic faith. Perhaps we can add our own name to the list of those who have been given a second (or third or fourth) chance to try again.

One of the greatest gifts that Jesus has given the Church is the Sacrament of Reconciliation, that is, the opportunity to go to Confession, acknowledge our guilt, and be restored to God's grace. In these coming days before Easter, we will have many opportunities to go to Confession and be better prepared to share in the life of the Risen Christ.

Along this same theme, have you noticed the wonderful articles in the bulletin about the revelations of Saint Faustina concerning Divine Mercy Devotions? Jesus' messages to Saint Faustina can be very reassuring to us concerning the great mercy that God shows to each of us. In addition to the many scheduled times for Confession before Easter, multiple priests will also be available on Divine Mercy Sunday (April 27) from 2 PM to 3 PM for Confessions.

Take advantage of the second chance that God is willing to give to all of us!

Liturgy Spotlight

The Veiling of Images and Crosses

Crosses and images may be veiled on the Fifth Sunday of Lent. Crosses are unveiled following the Good Friday Liturgy, while images are unveiled before the beginning of the Easter Vigil. The veiling is offered as an option, at the discretion of the local pastor. The veiling of crosses and images is a sort of "fasting" from sacred depictions which represent the paschal glory of our salvation. Just as the Lenten fast concludes with the Paschal feast, so too, our fasting from the cross culminates in an adoration of the holy wood on which the sacrifice of Calvary was offered for our sins. Likewise, a fasting from the glorious images of the mysteries of faith and the saints in glory, culminates on the Easter night with a renewed appreciation of the glorious victory won by Christ, risen from the tomb to win for us eternal life. An important part of the Good Friday Liturgy is the veneration of the cross, which may include its unveiling. Neither the Stations of the Cross nor stained glass windows are ever veiled. The veils are usually made of lightweight purple cloth without any decoration.




