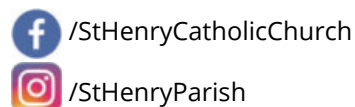

# From the Pastor's Desk

*Financial reports and budgets for our parishes and school.*

Sometime in the next few weeks, you will receive, as part of this bulletin, a summary report on the prior fiscal year, and of the budget for the current fiscal year which began July 1. The reason I am uncertain about the exact timing is that I would prefer the report for all three parishes appear the same weekend.

This information has all been reviewed by the finance committees and me, and you will see that our three parishes are all in very good financial shape. Anyone who wants more information than these summaries provided is welcome to contact our parish offices and ask for a full report.

*A new priest!* A few weeks ago, a priest new to the area stopped in: Father Milan Kasperek, who belongs to the "Eparchy of Parma (Ohio)," for the Byzantine Catholic Church. Remember that the entire Catholic Church is made up of many "families"; we Latin Catholics are the biggest, but there are many others, including the Byzantine, or Greek, Catholic Church. "Eparchy" is equivalent to "diocese," except the eparchy of Parma stretches over seven states! His congregation, Saint Barbara, used to meet just up S.R. 741 from St. Henry, but now meets at the Wright State University Catholic chapel; Father Kasperek lives near St. Henry, and I invited him to join our other priests for dinner recently. You may see him concelebrate Mass, or hear confessions, or help out in other ways.

*Beware of gift card scam.* I get tired of talking about this, but people keep asking, and I want to prevent anyone from being hooked. Scammers create an email pretending to be me – it is not the email listed below, which is the only one I use for parish business – and they try to get you to buy gift cards, and then give information over the Internet. It's theft and fraud and it isn't me. It will NEVER be me; tell everyone, please?

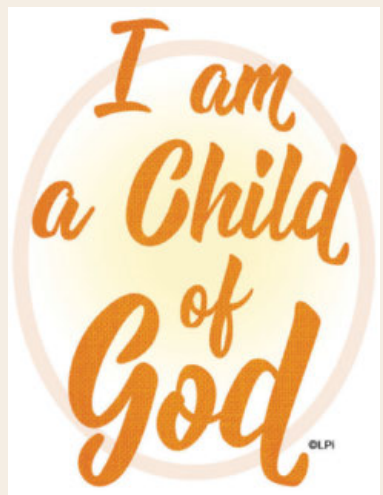

## **SAINT VINCENT DE PAUL** **FEAST: SEPTEMBER 27**

St. Vincent de Paul is much more than a patron saint of thrift shops!

Young Vincent became a priest hoping to advance and rise above his modest upbringing.

His early ambition amounted to little when he was assigned to a poor rural parish. Here he experienced a new joy in his vocation.

Hearing the profound deathbed confession of a dying servant, Vincent became more convinced of the special attention that must be given to the poor.

In 1625, Vincent founded the Congregation of the Mission for the purpose of caring for the poor.

Originally priests only, the mission expanded to include groups of laity who provided for spiritual and material needs of the poor in each parish.

Nearly 400 hundred years later, his legacy lives on!

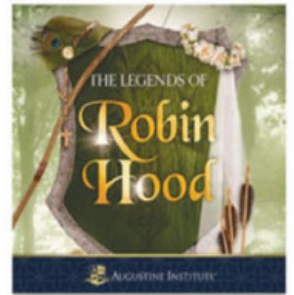
