

# Thank You from Fr. Dennis Koltz


Fr. Dennis Koltz, who celebrated a farewell Mass in Saint Winifred Church on July 13<sup>th</sup>, wished to extend the following message:

# Mission Appeal







The purpose of this appeal is to raise essential financial support for the Diocese of Murang'a, which is currently experiencing severe economic hardship.
