Dearly beloved parishioners,

While reading on the Gospel, I remember one time in the seminary when I was transferred to a room where a potted plant was left by the previous occupant. This plant caught my attention and there was a desire in me to take care of the plant. It had very few leaves remaining, some were almost dried. In short the plant was dying. I gave the plant all the love, care and attention that I could give. I placed it near the window so that it could get enough sunlight and I started watering the plant. Within a few days, new leaves started to sprout; the plant was rejuvenated. We heard today as the central message of the Gospel about the greatest commandment. It is about **the commandment of the love of God and neighbor**. Our love of God finds its concrete expression in love of others. Let us be aware that there is a close connection between what we do to our neighbor whom we see and what we do to God whom we cannot see. This love of God and love of neighbor is symbolized by **the two beams of the cross**. It is our call to balance **the vertical dimension** of our **love of God** in prayer and sacrifices with the **horizontal dimension** of our **love of neighbor** in mutual and loving service. Just like the wood of the cross that hangs the savior of the world, let our love of God be the vertical beam and the love of neighbor as the horizontal beam to bring new life. Let us handle it with care so that like the plant that is being watered, it will sprout and grow and bear so much fruit of good works. The good thing to be in love is that we need not to do big things at the onset. We can start doing little things with love from where we are at present and let this love spread. We can perhaps learn from Mother Teresa of Calcutta, who once said: "God has created us to do small things with great love. I believe that the great love that comes or should come from our heart, should start at home: with my family, my neighbors across the street, those right next door and this love should then reach everyone." Our commitment to love God can only find meaning and truthfulness in its relation and expression in our passion to love our neighbor. Fr. Damien of Hawaii expressed his love for God by caring for the lepers of Molokai by which towards the end of his life, he became a leper himself. For indeed the love of God and neighbor is also just like two sides of a coin that is inseparable. **May the Eucharist we celebrate today be not only a celebration of our love for God but also be a celebration of our endless love for one another.**

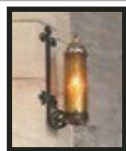
