From Our Rector

Dear sisters and brothers in Christ,

Our Cathedral renovation continues as planned in anticipation of our Golden Jubilee. The stained-glass Rose Window was installed, which already is making the east facade prominent and attractive for those driving on Glebe Road.

On the south side, facing Route 50, the installation of the stained glass will continue through the Spring.

The new architectural design will have the effect of diminishing the prominence of the Christ statue.

As a result, priests and advisors on the renovation project recommended to Bishop Burbidge that the Christ statue be transferred to a location that would preserve the prominence of the statue.

Their recommendation was to transfer the statue to Christ the Redeemer Parish in Sterling, VA, where it would be highly visible from Route 7, and better mark the location of the church.

After reflecting upon this recommendation, Bishop Burbidge accepted it.

I hope you join me in celebrating that this statue will continue to bear witness to Our Lord in this diocese and have new life at Christ the Redeemer.

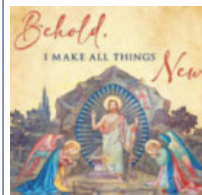
Join us to pray the Rosary!

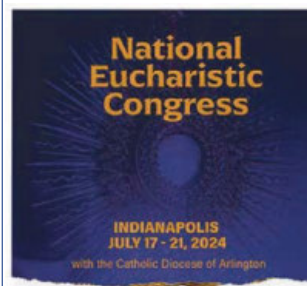

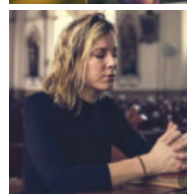

La recomendación fue transferir la estatua a la parroquia del Cristo Redentor en Sterling, VA, donde sería muy visible desde la Ruta 7 y marcaría mejor la ubicación de la iglesia.

Después de reflexionar sobre esta recomendación, el obispo Burbidge la aceptó.

Espero que se unan a mí para celebrar que esta estatua continuará dando testimonio de Nuestro Señor en esta diócesis y tendrá nueva vida en Cristo Redentor.

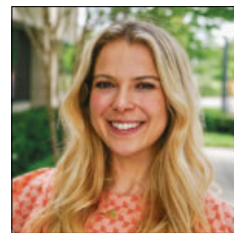
