



STEWARDSHIP

RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

The Daily Examen of Stewardship – Tracy Earl Welliver, MTS ©OLPi

"Stewardship" can get a bum rap these days. When folks hear the term "stewardship" from the pulpit, their eyes tend to kind of glaze over. "Here's Father asking for more money," they groan inwardly, "Get ready for the passing of the pledge cards."

Christ refutes this idea when he gives us what he calls the greatest commandments – instructing us to love God and to love our neighbor. Now, Christ is a man who chose his words carefully. He meant exactly what he said – and he didn't say that the greatest commandments were to tithe and to give money to charity. If he had wanted stewardship to be only about money, he would have said so.

Sometimes we are indeed called to show our love for God and neighbor in the form of a financial gift. But the concept of Everyday Stewardship – living mindfully in prayer, grateful for our blessings, and gracious to our neighbors, committed to God, and accountable to each other – is about so much more.

I propose a twist on the long-held practice of the "Daily Examen" – a pious devotion wherein, at day's end, we go over the events of the last 24 hours and discern God's will. A Daily Examen of Stewardship might contain questions like this:

*How did I love God today? In whom did I love Him?
What did God give me today? With whom did I share it? What did I give to Him?
To whom did I reach out today? Who reached out to me?
Where was God on my list of priorities today? First? Second? Third, fourth?*

Hi again. I recently spoke about hunting and today I'd like to talk about gathering in the Fall as a family. Although we had enough to eat, anything we could put in our stomachs was a bonus. Each Fall we would walk in the woods to check out the scenery (Mom loved to go on walks.) and find surprise skeletons of raccoons and possums. There were lots of acorns and buckeyes and puffball mushrooms but nothing to feed the hungry child. Finally, we would find hickory nut and walnut trees. We had to get there before the squirrels but managed to pick up enough nuts for future cookies and cakes. (The real reason Mom came along was so that we would bring enough nuts back for Winter goodies and not just for a snack.)

After we collected our treasures we would take them back to the house to store in the basement. Later that Winter us kids would go down the basement to crack open the nuts and handed them over to Mom. Sure there were some shells left after we removed the nuts but that made it more of an adventure to eat the cookies.

One additional food to be gathered was the pawpaw. Our family did not pick up pawpaws and put them in our pockets. We ate them on the spot. It was nice to have a little something sweet and juicy on our trip back from the woods. It would be nice if God's goodness was immediate but it is not always so. God's timing is always right but not always in sight. Those walks in the woods taught me to take my time in enjoying the fruits of God's goodness whether in the present or in the future.




