**OCIA**

Ms. MaryAnn Shine

This third Sunday of Advent is a rejoicing day when we think of the nearness of Christmas, or it should be. We have readings from Scripture that describe real people living the same experiences we can find very familiar to us. The prophet Isaiah, in his exuberance, can see a new world flowing from the world all around us, strengthening feeble hands and making firm the knees that are weak. So, if we are positive about the promises made in this prophecy we will be able to look up beyond our pains and troubles with a hope that is strong and lasting. There is always more to come. After floods and fires, don't we come together and rebuild? As holidays approach, don't we give more to feed the hungry and delight children with love and toys? This is the ever-growing kingdom that can bring joy and gladness. In the Letter of Saint James, we hear this advice: be patient. He uses the example of the farmer who waits. After all the hard work of plowing and planting, he waits. We do our best in preparing and praying, and God comes.

Matthew's gospel highlights a reality of faith in that it comes with questions. Here we meet John the baptizer, calling to repentance all those preparing the way of the Lord. When Jesus begins his own ministry, John has questions about what he has been hearing and wonders if the time has come. How will John know...how will we know? We can only travel with John, listening to his words, hearing that song from Godspell: 'Prepare ye the way of the Lord. prepare ye the way of the Lord.' John didn't stop his ministry, and neither should we. With that kind of faith, we will ask questions, and we'll find them where the kingdom is growing among us in our homes and parishes, our workplaces and volunteer opportunities. So, it's good to have Advent as a time to wait and prepare.

This Sunday we will meet for OCIA and look more closely at the meaning of the Incarnation. This will be our last meeting before Christmas and will meet again in the new year. Peace and blessings to all.
