Please contact the parish office to schedule a baptism. It is recommended that parents seeking Baptism for their child attend two baptismal preparation classes.


Sacrament of Marriage:

BELIEVE: with Fr. Steve

Catholic Schools Week is this week. Most of us in this area only know of one Catholic school: our own St. Augustine. In our area we have a very good public school system. But at the same time Catholic schools offer something our public school cannot—faith based education.

At one point the bishops in the United States of America mandated that every Catholic parish have a Catholic school. And that every Catholic family would send their children to that school. We had plenty of nuns who would teach our children and priests to teach as well.

Fast forward 50 years since The Second Vatican Council and we have closed hundreds of schools and churches. We no longer are obligated to send our children to Catholic schools nor does every parish have a school.

The church at the time, 100 years ago or so, asked every Catholic family to send their children to Catholic schools to protect our children from the poison they were hearing in secular schools, not to make money. They asked that our families continue to promote the Catholic faith and not the error of Protestantism that was perpetrated in our American schooling system at the time.

Has that changed much in our land today? We've seen a lot of issues continuing in the school system in our state—violence included. One of the most important things that we can do for our children, grandchildren, nieces and nephews is provide a solid faith based foundation at home. Our kids can be dropped off at any Catholic School, but if they're not hearing about Jesus at home and going to church on Sunday it won't stick whatsoever.

But having said that, a Catholic school affords them an added bonus of hearing more about the faith and learning about Jesus on a daily basis. Everywhere I have served I have had a Catholic school. Our school at St. Augustine, our principal, and our staff, have thoroughly impressed me. They are honestly fantastic—I cannot recommend our school enough to you and your family.

St. Augustine School Celebrates Catholic Schools Week January 30th—February 5th


Since 1974, National Catholic Schools Week is the annual celebration of Catholic education in the United States. This year's theme is




