## *"Mark"ing our Moments*

This week we give thanks to God as individuals, family, friends and community. At a recent meeting in the Archdiocese of Detroit, Archbishop Vigneron asked us what we thought was the greatest temptation pulling us away from the Lord, and a senior priest wisely answered, "Lack of gratitude." I was really struck by this comment. I was led to think about all of the times in my life or in the stories that I've heard of others when fatigue and distraction got the best of me and my thoughts, feelings and desires started to stray into grumbling rather than gratitude. It is such a temptation for each of us to get lost in the many things to be done, or the many strongly negative feelings we can experience in life, and forget the forest for the trees, that is, focus only on the many little daily distractions in life.

I love the story of Martha and Mary. Jesus is in the room and Mary is sitting at his feet listening to him while Martha is doing all of the serving without any help from her sister Mary. In her frustration, Martha runs to Jesus and asks him to demand that she help her. The passage in our New American Bible version says, "Martha, *burdened* by much serving..." leading us to feel bad for her because she has a lot to do and nobody is helping her. The problem is that the Greek word for "burdened" is *perispaō* (περισπάω), which means "to draw around (peri), draw away, distract, be cumbered by." So, let's rewrite that passage with this change to one word as, "Martha, *distracted* by much serving..." and we see a new meaning emerge. Martha wasn't just busy with a lot of work, she was distracted from God because of her work. Now Jesus' response makes more sense when he says, "Martha, Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things. Mary has chosen the better part and it will not be taken from her." In other words, Mary recognized that the God of all glory is sitting in her living room and she is not going to let herself be distracted from this amazing moment by something lesser to be done! She is solely focused on what's important in that particular moment. She is not distracted by the many tasks, but knows that, in this particular moment, she should rest at God's feet in awe and thanksgiving. Let's recognize how we have maybe become distracted in life, leading us to ingratitude and fight it! When we discover that everything is a gift, we realize the secret to happiness – an eye for the good, the pure, and the beautiful, taking the time to smell the roses, and to see that every moment, every lesson has been a gift.

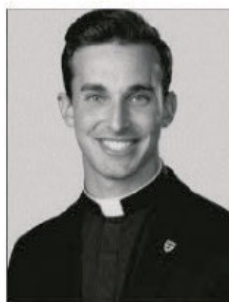

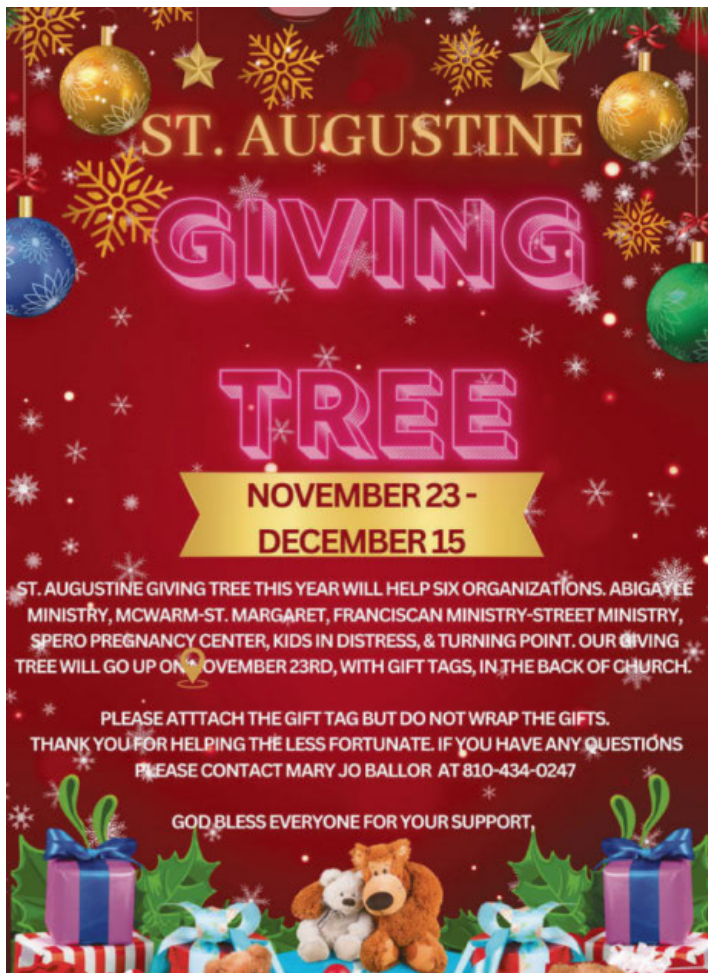
