



Greetings from "Father Louis Lapeyre"

When I was recently visiting relatives in Bakersfield California, I had the experience of torrential rains and thunder and lightning which was remarkable. It was remarkable because it was in Bakersfield. You can put Emphasis on the *"bake"* part of the name because, in California, the dried-up inland sea outside of Los Angeles rarely receives rain, let alone thunderstorms in June.

Since this is the Month of June, we remember especially the devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, who we remember desires reconciliation and mercy between all of us and God. In the Catholic tradition, the Sacred Heart has been closely associated with Acts of Reparation to Jesus Christ. In the Bible, God promised the Israelites that He would send down rain upon them so that their harvests would be abundant, and they would be satisfied (Deut 11:13-15). He only wished that they would listen to his commandments and keep them. At the Heart of reconciliation with Jesus is the intention to keep the commandments of God, to be changed in one's ways to following God. How important it is that we remember that our acts of repentance be followed by sincere conversion!

You may not know this, but California is a very agricultural state ... you can grow anything as long as there is water. So huge rainfalls in June are very welcome to a community which often has to resort to agriculture by irrigation. Rain in the bible is often regarded as a blessing to us, and we should look to the Sacred Heart of Jesus this June remembering that the reconciliation God has for us, and His Mercy for us, is always to see us succeed virtuously that we might experience reminders of what can await us in heaven with Him.

Since this weekend is Father's Day, I wish a Happy Father's Day to all those who are Fathers

who have a Heart for their Children in their successes and safety. May God rain down His blessings upon your families and reward you for every goodness!
