## Greetings From Father Lapeyre



Did you know that the first Catholic Diocese in the United States was the Archdiocese of Baltimore? After the Revolutionary War it was recognized by the Vatican that it would be important for Catholics living in the United States to have their own ecclesiastical jurisdiction ... formalized in 1789, creating the current Archdiocese of Baltimore. The first Bishop was Bishop John Carroll, who was a native of Maryland and a Jesuit Priest who was ordained Bishop the next year. At this time, the jurisdiction of the entire United States fell under the Archdiocese of Baltimore. Today, there are almost two hundred Dioceses, or ecclesiastical jurisdictions, in the United States.

Catholics in the territory of the Archdiocese of Detroit existed first under the jurisdiction of the Archdiocese of Quebec. After the Revolutionary war, the de facto jurisdiction for all Catholics then became part of the Archdiocese of Baltimore. It was not until March 8, 1833, that the Archdiocese of Detroit was formed. Today, all Catholics in the Counties of Lapeer, Macomb, Monroe, Oakland, St. Clair and Wayne are under the jurisdiction of the Archdiocese of Detroit.

There is a great deal of history regarding the Catholic Church in the USA.

From its beginnings since before the Revolutionary war, during, and even today, Catholics have always been part of the fabric of the United States of America. As faithful Catholics, we are obligated to give allegiance to the nation where we reside, and follow the civil laws of that country to the best of our conscience and Catholic Faith allows. The Roman Catholic Church in total has its own canon law, which is a fully developed legal system with courts, lawyers, judges and a fully articulated legal code. In addition to civil laws of a nation, Catholics are also bound to follow Canon Law.

As a nation in existence for over two hundred years, the people of the United States and American Catholics have pledged their allegiance to the ideals of life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness. Even when individuals and institutions have fallen short of those ideals, these principles are integral to the nation's founding and reasons for its independence. In the Declaration of Independence, the founders acknowledged these rights as inalienable and endowed by the creator God. Say a short prayer for greater fidelity to God and in thanksgiving for the benefits we enjoy in our country today.
