





If I missed anyone, I apologize. In order to get Service Credits for Working, please remember to sign in on the day you work for credits! I hope we can get some of the parents of the kids who attend Holy Cross School, to offer their assistance in working during the prep work: Wednesdays from 12:00 Noon until 3:00 pm, breaking down the fish, putting them on trays to thaw in the cooler; Thursdays from 9:00 am until 2:00 pm to help cut fish, make coleslaw, help with the rolls and lemon quarters, making the 5-Cheese Macaroni and Cheese, and seafood chowder; Friday mornings, from 9:00 am to 12:00 Noon, setting out cookies and desserts in zip-lock bags, setting up drinks, coffee and tea. On Friday afternoon, we set up and work serving on the buffet line. We can always use help cleaning up and wiping down tables, returning the serving trays to the kitchen and packing up the food after the dinner. We can also use help with the clean up early Saturday morning: to strain the fish Fryers oil, the French-fry oil, loading dishes into the dishwasher and cleaning up the counters and floors of the kitchen. With help, we can be out of there by 11:00 am or 12:00 noon.

Our Church is blessed with bakers who bring cakes or cookies for dessert. The ladies who host the Hospitality at Holy Cross Church each month, also grace our Fish Fry dessert table with many delicious items. Karen Beauvais Raymond is assisted by her sister, Judy Beauvais, who bakes lovely brownies, cakes and other delicacies that will sweeten your palette after your dinner!




