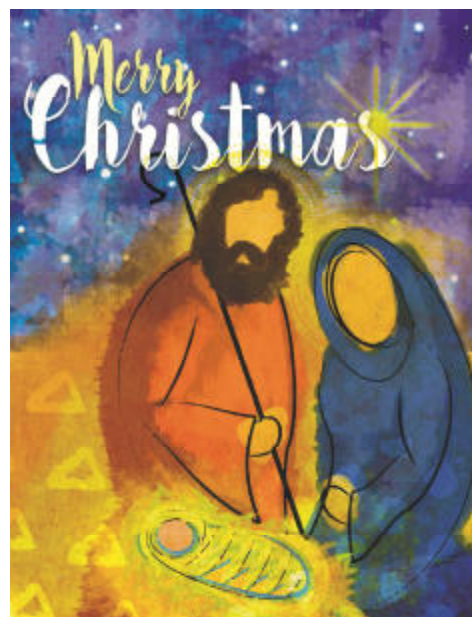
We must look at the past and learn from lived experiences.
