The faithful may, if they choose, participate in Mass on January 1, but there is no obligation to.

### Unleash the Gospels – Living and Sharing the Good News

Brothers and sisters: Put on, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, heartfelt compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience, bearing with one another and forgiving one another, if one has a grievance against another; as the Lord has forgiven you, so must you also do. And over all these put on love, that is the bond of perfection. (Colossians 3:12-15)

Today's Gospel (Luke 2: 41-52) gives us the story behind the 5<sup>th</sup> Joyful Mystery of the Rosary: The Finding of Jesus in the Temple. Jesus, Mary, and Joseph were on their annual trip for Passover to Jerusalem. Mary and Joseph leave Jerusalem and journey towards home for a day, thinking that Jesus is in the caravan with other family members and friends, not an unusual occurrence. Discovering that He is not in the caravan, they return to Jerusalem and find Jesus in the Temple in the midst of teachers, listening to them and asking questions. Mary and Joseph let Jesus know about the anxiety they have experienced during their search for Him and ask why He has done this to them. Jesus responds that He must be about His Father's business. Jesus does return to Nazareth with them, and as an obedient Son, grows in wisdom, age and favor before God and man.

Jesus is the perfect, obedient child who continues to grow in wisdom and realizes that He must do the will of God, the Father, as a priority, while being respectful of His earthly parents. Jesus also exemplifies the advice given in St. Paul's letter to the Colossians. To be a beloved member of a human family and God's family, we all must strive to be holy, and practice the virtues of kindness, compassion, humility, patience, gentleness, and forgiveness. The binding factor in making a happy and holy family is to show love in words and deeds at all times as we live and work within our family and the family of God, the Church. We are called and commissioned by our Baptism to help the members of our family, and all the members of God's family to the knowledge, love and service of God so salvation can be theirs.

Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, I love you, save souls. Pray. Encounter. Grow. Witness.

Jesus, Eternal High Priest, give us men willing to sacrifice and serve. Make their hearts after your own Sacred Heart.




