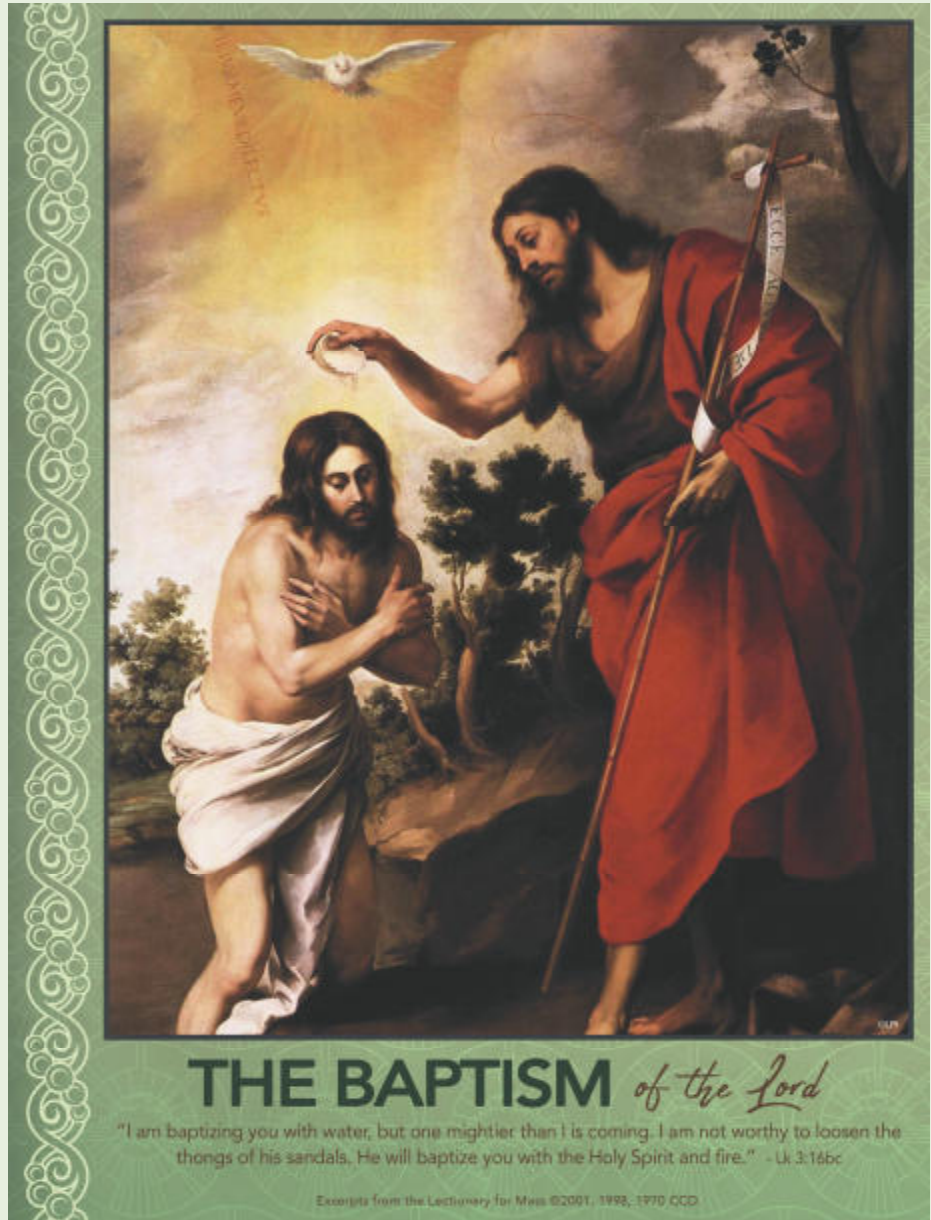

## FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Happy feast of the Baptism of the Lord! Today we commemorate the great moment in the life of our patron, John the Baptist, where he baptizes the very author of Baptism. Of course, we know that our Lord doesn't need to be baptized—He is already holy and without sin. However, by His entering the waters of the Jordan He sanctifies the waters for us. Now, as we are baptized, we can experience the same realities present for Him in His humanity. We experience the outpouring and anointing of the Holy Spirit, the heavens are opened above us, and the Father speaks His blessing, “you are my beloved son or daughter, in whom I am well pleased.” The Father's love is not dependent on having done anything, rather it is His gift. Jesus' ministry flows from these realities—a deep confidence and knowledge of the Father's love and walking in the anointing of the Holy Spirit. Our mission as Christians is meant to flow from those same realities. Today, let's ask the Lord to renew those graces from our own Baptism, that we might be empowered to walk as Jesus did, bringing His kingdom with us wherever we go.
