

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Let our only glory be the cross of our Lord, Jesus Christ! St. Paul, as he concludes his letter to the Galatians, boasts of this reality—it is only the cross of Jesus that brings transformation. Any fruit in our work of proclaiming the Gospel is only borne from the Cross of our Lord. So, let us stay close to the cross, and with St. Paul allow our hearts and lives to be poured out for the sake of the Gospel.

Insurance Claim: As I announced last weekend, there were financial irregularities under the prior pastor regarding inappropriate use of parish resources. Law enforcement was notified and the parish made an insurance claim. That insurance claim has now resulted in the payment of \$408,000. It remains unclear what law enforcement intends to do with the matter. This money does come directly to the parish, and we are grateful that this will contribute directly to the roof project.




