Although we had sad news last week, there is much good news to share about our parish.

For starters: we are growing. Our parish family continues to grow in members both young and old. And we are seeking ways to continue growing in faith and fellowship. During Lent, Soup and Substance with "Formed" was a big success; Shawl Ministry continues to bear fruit; the St. Patrick/St. Joseph dinner, though belated, was a great time together; Bible Studies are great source of grace; and Fish Fries and the Harvest Fest brought many people together, and our youth group and religious education are going strong—I hope that we continue supporting these initiatives and exploring how to make them even more enriching for our faith and our parish family. The members of the Parish Pastoral Council will continue working toward these ends in the fall.

Additionally, thanks to your generosity and the faithful stewardship of previous pastors and Deacon Stan, our parish enjoys good financial health. Simply put, our income meets expenses and we have enough money saved (through Sunday collections, DSA, and ongoing contributions to Witness to Hope) to cover future capital projects (Holy Family Center room "partitions", parking lot improvements, etc.)—but I plan to write more about those projects in future bulletin articles and to present a more comprehensive and transparent Annual Report about the status of our parish in the fall. Along those lines, our parish recently hired Pamela Armstrong as a part-time bookkeeper (Joyce Armitage will continue serving as our parish secretary), and the Parish Finance Council has been helping to draw up our parish operating budget for 2019–2020. As I mentioned last week, our parish will be hiring a new part-time business manager for the parish (someone to oversee the management of the parish finance, facilities, and staff)—and the Parish Finance Council and Parish Pastoral Council will take part in this hiring process.
