From Fr. Pieter

Greetings! Merry Christmas! Who's that priest and where is Fr. Pieter? Since I have a break from teaching at the seminary I took a few days of vacation before the new school year. In my absence, I am happy that Fr. Joe Campbell can celebrate Mass and confession for us (thank you, Fr. Joe!). Fr. Campbell grew up in Ann Arbor (his family attends Christ the King parish), and now he serves as chaplain at Lansing Catholic High School.

What does God say to us in Mass today? We see God's faithfulness. We all need someone to trust. We need someone we can lean on no matter what. We desire someone trustworthy who will never abandon us, who is utterly, totally, unhesitatingly, faithful. And we find this "someone" in our Triune God.

More than 500 years before Christ's birth, God had promised, through his prophet Isaiah, that he was going to lead "all the nations" to Jerusalem to share in the light of salvation. In spite of 500 years of wars, migrations, and historical turbulence that re-wrote the map of the civilized world three different times, God did what he said he was going to do. The Wise Men came from the non-Jewish world; they represent the nations. By coming to Christ, they enter into the light of salvation bringing gifts.

Knowing that God is faithful is the foundation of our whole spiritual life (Catechism #222). Believing in God, the only One, and loving him with all our being has enormous consequences for our whole life... It means trusting God in every circumstance, even in adversity. A prayer of St. Teresa of Jesus (which I shared at Mass a few weeks ago) wonderfully expresses this trust:

- Let nothing trouble you / Let nothing frighten you
- Everything passes / God never changes
- Patience / Obtains all
- Whoever has God / Wants for nothing

God alone is enough.
