

Greetings! Today we see Jesus at the Wedding Feast at Cana. Jesus shows us that he is the true "master of the feast"! Jesus fulfills our hearts deepest longings as the true "Bridegroom" of our hearts—He promises to bring us into intimacy with God that earthly relationships can only echo. Jesus makes possible this "Wedding Feast" at the hour of His passion and death, and it is perfected when we join God in Heaven, but we begin this intimacy with Him now through faith, prayer, and our Eucharistic union with Him. Pray to Him and adore Him to whom you are joined in the Eucharist. Truly "blessed are those who are called to the wedding supper of the Lamb."
