

SALAM ! SHALOM ! PAX ! PEACE ! And, as we always say here at Resurrection, ALL ARE WELCOME ! This is the Fifth Sunday of the Season of Easter – our ‘feast season’- here at Resurrection. This week our continued celebration of the Victory over Sin and Death – which are still very real and very close, but no longer in control – is united with two other such events. Friday is FIRST FRIDAY. As usual, we will have MASS, including both the SACRED HEART devotion as well as the ANOINTING of the SICK. Recalling when, in the

Gospel of St. Mark, Jesus sent the Apostles to the villages to anoint and heal – as St. James also recalls in his Epistle - it is a celebration over Sin and Death. Wednesday is CINCO de MAYO – one of the Mexican ‘independence days’ – usually involving pinatas and parties. Both call us to not just ‘look back’, but to look forward – to commit ourselves to being people of FAITH ALIVE. Please join us on Friday. Pray for the people of Mexico on Wednesday – that as our good neighbors they have the benefits of Faith, Hope and Love as well as Respect, Dignity and Joy.

Next week, of course, is Mother’s Day. We all pray that it will be a wonderful time, good weather and all. It will certainly be a swell time to ‘return to Mass’ for so many. So, here’s hoping that it is warm and inviting. And what ever plans you have for Mother’s Day, include some prayers of THANKS and PROTECTION.

As you are aware, each year the AOD – the Archdiocese of Detroit – has its CSA – Catholic Services Appeal. Because of the pandemic, the schedule was adjusted somewhat recently. Wherever I am, my servants will be.


Glory to God in the Highest




