The CRC who administers the clinic has received funding from a non-profit called CoCoDA (Companion Communities Development Alternatives). By combining that with the additional funding supplied by Resurrection Parish the CRC is making much needed repairs and improvements to the clinic. Help Our Confirmation Candidates Help Others!

Resurrection's Confirmation candidates have learned about children in need in our community and they want to make a difference! In response to an urgent request from the U.S. federal government, Starr Commonwealth is opening its Albion campus to help alleviate the developing humanitarian challenge at the southern border. A leader in healing trauma and building resilience in children, Starr has signed a facilities agreement to allow the Administration for Children and Families to utilize its 350-acre campus as a safe haven. ACF intends to provide temporary shelter for up to 240 unaccompanied migrant children as it works to unite them with their family or sponsors.

SALAM ! SHALOMN ! PAX ! PEACE ! Jesus promised His followers that after He left He would send the Holy Spirit to guide, lead and protect them. Among what He promised is that the Spirit would give them a deeper appreciation and understanding of His teachings. The Church follows the Feast of Pentecost with a 'season of the Spirit' during which we are lead through several of these insights. This week-end we have the first - the Feast of the HOLY TRINITY. We are reminded that we believe there is but ONE GOD. However, we have the data from the New Testament that Jesus understood this One God as having three 'persons' – often called Father, Son and Holy Spirit as well as Creator, Savior / Redeemer and Sanctifier. We Catholics begin our prayers with an acknowledgement of Them. We are made in Their 'image and likeness' (cf. Gen.1:26). Among other things, this means we are at our best when we are truly COMMUNITY.

This brings us to our next celebration this week-end MEMORIAL DAY. Each year we set aside this time to remember, honor and pray for those who have given their lives for us. Through the decades there are certain groups who always are included. But this year we add so many others – some who are truly unexpected. Among those we will pray for at this time and for years to come are included all the medical and health personnel and the staffs at hospitals, nursing homes, home care, in pharmacies and the like. There are also the workers of all kinds in the stores, restaurants and services who have gotten us through this year – often without proper pay and benefits, often without even proper PPE (personal protection equipment). They have shown us 'at our best'. They have shown us what it means to be 'community'. We also add those who did not set out to be 'heroes' or 'essential', such as Trayvon Martin, Emmett Till and Floyd George. GOD BLESS THEM ALL ! May those who have died and their families know how much we truly treasure them. Please join us on MONDAY for the 9 am Mass of Remembrance.

This Friday, June 4, is FIRST FRIDAY. As we do each month, at the 8:30 am Mass there is the SACRED HEART Devotion as well as the Sacrament of the ANOINTING of the SICK. Please join us ! Deacon Paul usually joins us and delivers the homily. Of course, we will lift up in prayer all those involved in these 'healing ministries' and their families, as well as those in need of them. Please join us.

Again, CONGRATULATIONS to all the young people who received First Communion this past week-end ! I want to especially THANK Karen Hogan and both the REP and Office staff who organized and ran the 'show'. To enable us to maximize the number of people present while maintaining safe and comfortable distances, after each Mass – in addition to sanitizing – they adjusted where the chairs were. It was a lot of work. It paid off wonderfully. THANK YOU to all !
