

## THE REV SAYS...

My Brothers and Sisters,

Our Blessed Lord speaks a sobering message on the 26<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time- His words challenge us and should rightly wake us up. It may be hard to hear about the reality of Gehenna (Hell), yet our Lord instructs us how to avoid this lot by vigilance and avoiding scandal.

To be clear, Jesus is teaching about the danger of a faithful person (a believer, disciple) who leads others astray by their conduct. The Lord expects a disciple to both believe in Him and to represent Him by a holy life. If a Christian's supposed faith does not match his actions, he can lead others into sin...and the consequences are severe.

For one, we know how profoundly painful it is when a member of the clergy commits grave sin or crime- he uses his authority and role in the Church to get personal gain (greed, theft), to exploit the vulnerable (misconduct, abuse of minors) or to lord over those under his care (arrogance, laziness). St. Gregory the Great once commented:

*"He who therefore, after having been brought to a profession of sanctity, destroys others, either by word or example, it had been indeed better for him that his worldly deeds should render him liable to death..."* (Catena Aurea, Gospel of Mark 9:38-42)

Jesus invites sinful men to share in His perfect, holy priesthood and He has high standards for the clergy. Since we have been given much, much more is expected of us. Woe to the priest that scandalizes the faithful or misrepresents the Lord Jesus Christ. Though mercy and forgiveness can be found if scandal happens, yet the offender must spend the rest of his days in repentance and atonement. Please, pray for the clergy and ask God to make us holy. Please pray also for those who have been hurt and need the healing power of God.

For another, these words of Jesus affect all of the faithful, too. It applies to the way parents treat and lead their children; it applies to how siblings treat one another. It applies how we act in the workplace, school, and grocery store. We are Catholic at all times and in every place, and as such we all are supposed to represent Jesus in all that we do.

A great response to the Word of God this weekend could be an examination of conscience and to make a good Confession. We struggle and sometimes we fall into sin, but

Christ has given us a remedy of His mercy through the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Go to confession, or at least take some time to reflect on the way we live as a disciple of Jesus.

May God bless us and help us to stay watchful, to persevere in choosing the good, to resist sin and to stay close to the merciful Heart of His Son.
