Last weekend we observed the Sunday of the Word of God. Pope Francis, in His Apostolic Letter, Apostolic Letter, Motu proprio "Aperuit illis", established that the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time of each year will be devoted to the celebration, study and dissemination of the Word of God.

Our Archbishop Allen Vigneron, I believe encouraged by the Pope's Apostolic Letter and concerned about sharing the Gospel among Catholics in the Archdiocese of Detroit, wrote a Pastoral Letter "The Power of the Word of God" in which he stresses the role of Sacred Scripture in our lives. Reading the Scripture we may become wiser in our journey towards salvation. The culture that we live in provides for us demoralization, destabilization and chaos. Reading the Bible, particularly the New Testament, we learn how to become Christ like.

The Words of God are powerful. They affected Kings of Israel, Prophets and Mary and Joseph. At our time the Words of God inspired many people to change their lives. I am encouraging you to read the Scripture every day, pray and implement it into your daily life.

Thank you to Gary Zilli for continuing his Bible Study group on line that he was teaching before the pandemic began.

On February 2, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. we will have a Mass in honor of The Presentation of the Lord. Following the Mass, we will have a touchless Blessing of the Throats. On February 3, 2021, the Feast of Saint Blaise, at 12:00 p.m. we will have a short service with the Blessing of the Throats. This will be done in accordance with the Archdiocese of Detroit guidance where we cannot touch the people with the candles.



St. Faustina’s Diary is a compilation of her personal spiritual journey: how she encountered Jesus and what He said directly to her. It’s a beautiful testimony of faith, showing how trust in the Lord, especially in times of uncertainty and doubt is absolutely essential.

(275)+ Today, when I warned a certain young lady that she should not be standing for hours in the corridor with the men, because it was unbecoming for a well-bred young lady to do so, she apologized and promised to correct herself. She began to cry when she became aware of her thoughtlessness. As I was saying these few things to her concerning moral behavior, all the men from the ward came over and listened to my words of advice. The Jewish people even heard a few things about themselves. A certain person told me afterwards that they put their ears against the wall and listened attentively. I somehow felt they were listening, but I said what I had to say. The walls are so thin here that one can be heard, even when speaking in a low voice. 919 page 358

Report Abuse

Registration

Parishioners may register in person, by phone, or online.

Baptism

At least one parent needs to be registered, active and a practicing Catholic for at least six months. A Baptismal Preparation Class is required for both parents and godparents. The church requires that at least one of the godparents be an active and practicing Catholic. For more information call the Parish Office.

Marriages

Arrange at least six months in advance.

Communion Calls

Pastoral Staff members visit the sick in the hospital when possible and take Communion to the sick and homebound regularly. Names of the sick should be reported to the Parish Office.
