

Bible Study

We are offering a bible study on the Letter of James here at St Faustina Catholic Church. The bible study course consists of ten online sessions. There are four steps to each session:

Step one: At home before each virtual session the participants will read passages from the bible and answer questions relative to the readings. This will take about 90 minutes.

Step two: We will meet virtually once a week for ten weeks to discuss the readings and share the answers to the questions. The sessions will last about an hour.

Step three: The creator of the bible study, Jeff Cavins, wraps up each session with a 55-minute video presentation. We can view the video presentation right after the group discussion or, participants can view it on their own at home any time after the session but before the next one.

Step four: In the back of the workbook there are responses to all the questions. Each participant can review Jeff Cavins' responses to the questions for each session as a preparation for the next session.

Each participant will need a computer or notebook to participate in this study.

Report Abuse

Registration

Parishioners may register in person, by phone, or online.

Baptism

At least one parent needs to be registered, active and a practicing Catholic for at least six months. A Baptismal Preparation Class is required for both parents and godparents. The church requires that at least one of the godparents be an active and practicing Catholic. For more information call the Parish Office.

Marriages

Arrange at least six months in advance.

Communion Calls

Pastoral Staff members visit the sick in the hospital when possible and take Communion to the sick and homebound regularly. Names of the sick should be reported to the Parish Office.
