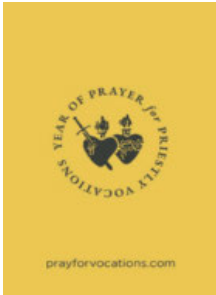

And here I see the role of the Holy Spirit—the third Person of the Holy Trinity—to create some type of living network that would connect us with everything that is created by God, particularly with one another. The Holy Trinity is very important in the existence of the Universe and the life of humanity.

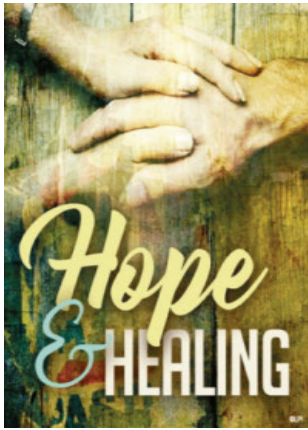
