August 15<sup>th</sup> is the day of the month that we observe the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Traditionally, in the past, it was an important day for Catholics to express their faith in the words Jesus said: "Where I am you also may be". She, herself, was sinless and she accepted death as her Son did for our salvation.
