August 15th is the day of the month that we observe the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Traditionally, in the past, it was an important day for Catholics to express their faith in the words Jesus said: "Where I am you also may be". The Mother of God was taken up to heaven, soul and body, after her earthly life. From the day of Jesus's birth she participated in the redemptive work of her Son. She, herself, was sinless and she accepted death as her Son did for our salvation. By the Feast of the Assumption and the Mass at 9 a.m. on Monday we are reminded about our destiny such as the eternal life in heaven. Each one of us like Mary is carrying within our bodies, which are the temples of the Holy Spirit, the seeds eternity. Mary's Assumption foreshadows our own entry into heaven.

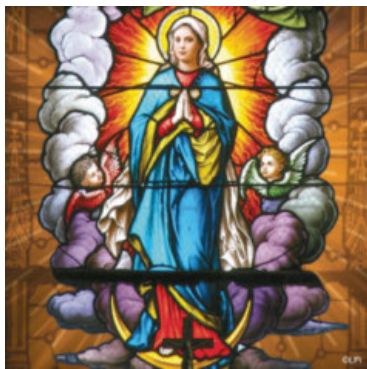

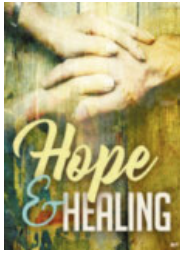
