Life Without Expectations 18th Sunday, Ordinary Time Marge Sears



As Gesu celebrates the Feast of St Ignatius this weekend in the midst of the Ignatian Year I reflect on this weekend's readings with St Ignatius's story in mind. As with the Israelites in the desert and Ignatius' cannonball injury, we all can realize that life doesn't always go as planned. After the initial celebration on being freed from Egyptian captivity, the Israelites find themselves starving in the desert. "Would that we died at the Lord's hand in Egypt... but you lead us into the desert to make the whole community die of famine." (Exodus) Ignatius, whose life dream was the military, had his dream end with his injury. For me, it was a combination of retirement, pandemic isolation and a knee replacement with ongoing complications. It is times like these that we must discern and seek what change is needed and what really nourishes us.

For the Exodus people, their hunger was filled by manna, a strange bread, provided from heaven by God. Ignatius was provided for by reading the lives of saints and of Christ which led him to conversion and seeing "all things new in Christ". For me there was no grand conversion or sign from heaven, but I am gradually learning to let go of expectations (when and how I will heal and how I am to use this retirement time) and finding God in the everyday.

In the gospel, Jesus tells the crowd, "I am the bread of life". We all seek nourishment from many sources, good and bad, but what God invites us to is "a new self, created in God's way" (Ephesians). God provides the way and the nourishment to a deeper relationship, an ongoing conversion. Life may not go as we expect or planned, but God is always with us, leading us and providing us with nourishment for our everyday human journey.


