## From the Pastor's Desk:

As you no doubt will notice next  
weekend, our **Advent Display** will be  
in the Gathering Area beginning  
November 20th. It is that time of the  
year again and the need is great for  
families struggling to have a little  
Christmas joy. The Giving Tree last  
year became the Tree Display. We  
will assemble the tree display like we  
did last year. The new Advent Display  
was designed with safety from  
COVID in mind. Like last year, there  
are no tags, in order to limit the need  
for touch. We suggest you take a  
photo of the tree display to take with  
you to purchase needed items.

The bulk of this year's gifts will  
consist of gift cards from retail stores  
listed on the display. Some other  
items needed - such as sweat suits,  
socks, toys and underwear - will also  
be listed on the display. The  
sponsoring agencies and/or churches  
will also be listed on the display.  
Again, you can access the infor-

clicking on the link that will appear on  
our Facebook page and the home  
page of our Website.

Not only does the purchase of gift  
cards limit exposure to COVID, but it  
also gives the families in need an  
opportunity to purchase their own  
gifts for their families. Who better to

## Advent Giving Tree 2021

A long standing Christmas tradition in our parish is the Advent Giving Tree, symbolizing God's gift of love for all people. ### Live Streaming Ministry

As many of you may now be aware, St. Thomas a'Becket recently underwent a major technological upgrade with the installation of a live streaming video system. Our new system allows us to live stream various liturgies directly to the homebound and those who are otherwise unable to attend mass in person. Future uses of the technology may include the ability to stream concerts and worship events, funerals, weddings, scripture presentations, and much more. As the Director of Liturgy for our faith community, I'm thrilled about the many opportunities now available to us to use this technology to not only keep our homebound parishioners connected to the parish, but also to welcome viewers from all over the United States who may wish to tune in.

The last several weeks of fine tuning and testing the video system have been met with great success and positive feedback. As we begin to implement weekly live streams on a consistent basis, I am in need of one final component – you! We are in need of tech-savvy individuals to operate the video system during mass. This mostly entails switching camera angles at various points during the mass to focus the viewer on the liturgical action. The system is very user friendly and easy to operate.

If you're looking for a unique and technology-focused way to volunteer here at the parish, I hope you might consider joining this group of video operators. One-on-one training will be available to anyone who wishes to join us, as well as shadowing and plenty of hands-on time with the system.


