Contact Change: Please notify the parish office when you move, change your email, phone number or family status.



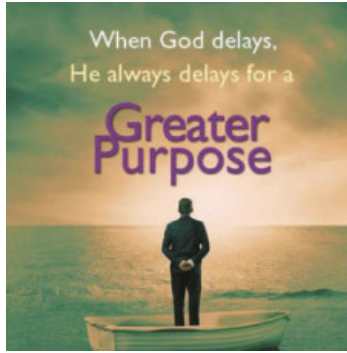
SVdP News

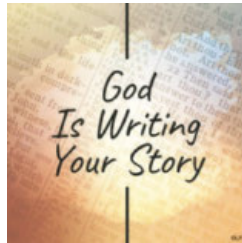
