The Easter Candle

Throughout Easter's fifty days the Pascal Candle stands, prominent and lofty in the middle of the Eucharistic Hall. As the center pole of the new creation, the candle is the Christ, the Alpha and Omega of all times and ages. It recalls how Jesus appeared to his disciples, displaying his wounds to them, and imparting the Spirit to them for the forgiveness of sins. Since the Easter Vigil is popularly taken as a celebration, the candle is understood to represent the Risen Christ.

Reflection in the various elements that decorate and adorn the candle, however, direct our thoughts to the one who was crucified. Five wax nails are inserted into the candle to signify the wounds that Jesus received in hands, feet and side when he was crucified. "By the body and the glorious wounds may Christ the Lord guard us and keep us." These wounds do not vanish. They remain with Jesus who repeatedly shows them to his disciples. They are offered as marks of recognition: "Look at my hands and my feet, it is really I" (Luke 24:39).

Easter Water

In the Liturgy of the Holy Saturday, the officiating priest solemnly makes the sacramental Easter Water, which the Church provides for the faithful to take home. This is to be used like Holy Water, to sprinkle on persons, house and rooms during

the Easter Season. A very pertinent custom would be for Catholic families to sprinkle the food on the Easter table with it. This will make Easter dinner as an unusually solemn and festive occasion and bestow upon the blessing which the Church wants all good things to have the "Feast of Feasts!"

Easter Sunday Collection

One of our largest collections is on Easter Sunday. The reason for this is that, almost all of our registered parishioners attend Mass on Easter. As I have said many times I am thankful for your generous giving to our Church. When you donate you help us provide the programs we provide to our families. I Would encourage you to donate what you can to the Easter collection. If you can give more, please do so. Let your gift be in thanksgiving to God for the blessings you have received. A good number of parishioners double their donation on Easter Sunday. I remember my Grandparents always doing that as a sign of their joy at Easter and their great love for the church. That may be something you can do this Easter. As we begin Holy Week let us continue to journey with Jesus to Jerusalem and the glory of Easter.

The Tomb is Empty... He is Risen!



We rejoice in our celebration of the Resurrection. Our hearts find hope as we recall the beautiful message of God's love for His people. The message of Easter is simple and basic. God's love is given to us as an experience being buried in pain and coming to life in joy. Our response to God's gifts reflects our faith once again giving us new hope. It is my prayer that Easter renews the joy filled life you have with Jesus and may you live that gift with hope.

A Reading from the Acts of the Apostles 10:34a, 37-43

Peter proceeded to speak and said: "You know what has happened all over Judea, beginning in Galilee after the baptism that John preached how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power. † A Reading From the Holy Gospel According to John 20:1-9

On the first day of the week, Mary of Magdala came to the tomb early in the morning, while it was still dark and saw the stone removed for the tomb. So she ran and went to Simon Peter and the other disciple whom Jesus loved and told them, "They have taken the Lord from the tomb and we don't know where they put him." So Peter and the other disciple went out and came to the tomb. They both ran, but the other disciple ran faster than Peter and arrived at the tomb first; he bent down and saw the burial clothes there, but did not go in. When Simon Peter arrived after him, he went into the tomb and saw the burial clothes there, and the cloth that had covered his head, not with the burial clothes but rolled up in a separate place. Then the other disciple also went in, the one who had arrived at the tomb first and he saw and he believed. For they did not yet understand the Scripture that he had to rise from the dead.

Extra Easter Trivia...

The Easter Bunny is among the Pennsylvania Dutch contributions to American folklore. The legend about the Easter Rabbit delivering eggs was introduced by German settlers who arrived in the 18th century. Their word for Bunny was Oschter Haws. Pricilla Sawyer-Lord and Daniel J. Foley (Chilton, 1971) write the bunny was suppose to be such a shy creature that it hid his nest of colored eggs in secluded spots on Easter Eve. The eggs were collected by "someone" who used their caps and bonnets as a "nest". Elaborate baskets that are known today came later when the tradition spread through the United States. Ever wonder where the expression "He who takes the cake" comes from? According the Irish legend it sprang from the sunrise dances of joy held Easter morning, Male villagers competed for a cake made by women villagers.

The egg rolling custom for children's Easter celebration is not confined to the White House lawn in Washington, D.C.

It is also popular in some European countries. It supposedly originated as a symbol of rolling a stone away from the entrance to Chris's tomb

Easter Lamb

The Easter Lamb representing Christ, with the Flag of Victory is the most significant symbol of the festive season. It may be seen in pictures and images in the homes of most families in Catholic parts of Europe. The liturgical use of the Paschal Lamb as a symbol for the Savior inspired the faithful of medieval times to eat lamb meat on Easter Sunday.

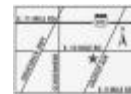

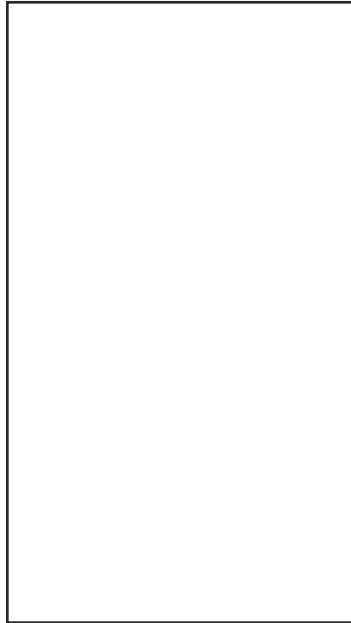
