Gianna House is a favored charity of the Michigan K of C that supports life. Gianna House is an organization that is housed at the old convent on the grounds of St. Veronica. This organization supports the unborn through education and life skills programming to pregnant women who are at risk of lack safe housing to transition them to independence.

The Knights of Leo XIII Council has raised money in different ways to support Gianna House. One of the ways we raise money is through our Baby Bottle Drive at St. Veronica. We have done this a few times in the past, where Baby Bottles are left are left in the front of the Church, parishioners can take a bottle, return it with change or bills and the Knights take the proceeds to Gianna House at the end of the Drive. We plan this drive from November until the end of the year.

The Power of the Grace That Flows From Confirmation

The prophets of the Old Testament foretold that God's Spirit would rest upon the Messiah to sustain his mission. Their prophecy was fulfilled when Jesus the Messiah was conceived by the Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. 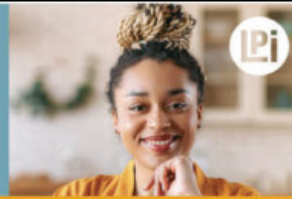

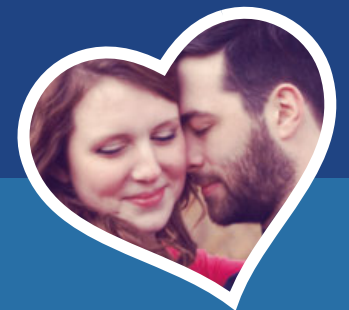
