


*We are so happy you have followed St. Therese's little way into our community of faith. In her own words, we hope "you trust God that you are exactly where you are meant to be."*

## Evangelization & Faith Formation

When I arrived in Calcutta, Mother Teresa's sisters asked me to come to an orientation for new volunteers. We were asked to write down our names and how long we would be volunteering on a small notecard. Equipped with those two pieces of information, the Missionaries of Charity would assign us to a particular ministry.

I was astonished when they assigned me to help in Shishu Bhavan, the orphanage just down the road. Having been the youngest in my family, I had very little experience with children! Further, I was assigned to work with the handicapped children who needed very particular care.

Each day I went to the orphanage with a sense of bewilderment. I couldn't communicate with the women in the home who spoke Bengali, and I had zero experience with handicapped children. After a month, I was asked to teach preschool for some of the children, another task I felt I was quite incapable of tackling!

The thing is, our natural capacities are insufficient. Our Catholic faith empowers us to see this truth as a cause for joy. Our insufficiency can lead us to the Lord God, who can empower us to do far more than we are capable of on our own— for His glory.

Our patroness Saint Therese teaches us to delight in our littleness. She once wrote, *"I am no longer surprised at anything, nor do I grieve at seeing that I am frailty itself; on the contrary I glory in it, and expect to discover new imperfections in myself each day. These lights concerning my nothingness do me more good, I affirm, than lights regarding faith"* (Story of a Soul, IX).

St. Therese delighted in her littleness because of her incredible confidence in God's love for her and His ability to work through her to bless others. St. Therese saw herself as a little child before God, asking to be picked up.

Let's join with St. Therese in celebrating our own littleness! Let's grow in the virtue of humility this month, with our patroness.

When was the last time you were bewildered by what others asked of you? When was the last time you stepped out of your comfort zone to serve others? We have two great opportunities for you to grow in humility this fall...




## All are invited!

## The Little Way of Humility



St. John of the Cross

St. John of the Cross and St. Teresa of Avila found the Carmelites too relaxed in their rule, so they tried to reform the order. Many resisted them and the order was split in half, and they founded the Discalced Carmelites.

St. John faced opposition from many sides.

He endured imprisonment, being stripped of his offices, and banishment. With humility he tried to do God's will, not his own. He was rewarded with deep spiritual mystic experiences which led to his writings. He was given the title of Doctor of the Church.

Many families have benefited from this support group, new friendships have formed, allowing a place to relate to the struggles of single-parenting.





### Vote NO on Proposal 3

For the past two weeks, we've been discussing Proposal 3 (the "Reproductive Freedom for All" proposal), and how it will amend Michigan's Constitution to create a startling broad right to abortion. In Week 1, we learned that the proposal's broad language (giving the right to "every individual") authorizes a minor to obtain an abortion without parental consent or notice. In Week 2, we learned that the same would be true if a minor sought a sterilization procedure, and that the proposal would also authorize partial-birth abortion.

Proposal 3's supporters say that the State will still be able to regulate abortion "after fetal viability." But that is grossly misleading. The proposal specifically allows abortion through all nine months of pregnancy—notwithstanding any contrary Michigan law—if an abortionist decides, in his professional judgment, that an abortion is necessary to protect the "physical or *mental health*" of the mother. As a legal matter, such a "mental health" exception is widely acknowledged to be so broad as to justify abortion on demand until birth. An abortionist need merely document that the prospect of having a child is causing extreme anxiety and stress for the mother. And while Proposal 3 supporters say a judge won't have to allow such a broad exception, the proposal's language specifically requires courts to defer to the abortionist's "professional judgment."

No matter how a voter feels about abortion, Michigan's Constitution should not be amended to allow abortion on demand through all nine months of pregnancy. Please tell everyone you know: vote "**NO**" on Proposal 3 on November 8th. (**John Bursch is a constitutional lawyer and former Michigan Solicitor General.** Through Alliance Defending Freedom, he represents the Michigan Catholic Conference and Right to Life of Michigan in court to uphold Michigan's pro-life laws.)




