Don't Preach To Me!



Don't preach to me! Most of us don't like being preached to whether the preacher be one's spouse, parents, teachers, neighbors, etc. We don't mind hearing some preaching at Mass, though. In fact, we expect being preached to there! We hope and pray, however,

that it's good preaching (believe me when I tell you that priests and deacons feel the same way!), or at least that the preaching is quiet enough, so one can take a quick nap!

In today's Gospel reading from St. Mark, it's very interesting that Jesus notes that preaching is the primary focus of His ministry: "Let us go on to nearby villages that I may preach there also. For this purpose have I come" (emphasis added). Most of us believe that a priest's primary job (ministry) is to celebrate Mass. While celebrating the Mass is, arquably, the most important task for a priest, the first job of a priest is to preach! Likewise, all the baptized are called to preach (or proclaim) the Good News of Jesus Christ. The famous pithy saying that is often used, and is erroneously attributed to St. Francis, "Preach the Gospel and use words if necessary," is cute, but we can see from today's reading that, if we are to be imitators of Christ, then we are to preach and proclaim the Gospel vocally! Through our baptism we share in Christ's three offices of Priest, Prophet, and King. We are, therefore, firstly called to preach even when others may not like it.

In our second reading today, St. Paul acknowledges in his letter to the Corinthians that he should not boast for his preaching, since he is obligated to preach the gospel, the *Good News*, because God Himself commanded Paul to preach the gospel to both Jews and Gentiles alike. If Paul preached purely from his own free will, voluntarily, he might have something to boast about. But Paul is simply doing

what God has required him to do, and thus Paul is not entitled to any payment or reward. In our own baptism in Christ, we are all called to preach or *proclaim* the Gospel, the Good News, to all nations (everyone) (Mt. 28:19-20). By doing so, our reward will be great in Heaven!

I thank the parents, grandparents, coaches, our priests, alumni, and all those who make a positive and nurturing impact on our students' lives.

Also, **one cannot take blessed ashes home or elsewhere** to be imposed on others.






There are containers in each of the church's vestibules to place old blessed palms in. These palms are burned for the ashes used on Ash Wednesday.


On January 18th, the eve before the March for Life, Bishop Michael Burbidge of Arlington, Virginia, the chairman of the U.S. Catholic bishops' Committee on Pro-Life Activities, delivered a homily to those attending the Respect Life Vigil mass. He reminds those in Michigan and other pro-abortion states to not lose hope. His words focus our attention on being light in the darkness. "We must continue to be strategic in states where there are victories to be won. In other places, where states have acted to enshrine extreme abortion policies into law, we must not lose hope.

Like Jesus, it is not enough to reserve our message for those who will readily receive it, and to pursue victories only in those places where we are likely to win. We must persist in those places where our message is rejected. We must bring light to the darkest corners. For "every child who, rather than being born, is condemned unjustly to being aborted, bears the face of Jesus Christ," Pope Francis says. Every life that is saved is loved by God and endowed with inviolable dignity. Every life is worth the effort"

St. Stanislaus Kostka, Poland, 1567

St. Stanislaus was born in Poland to a noble family. He and his brother were sent to a Jesuit college to prepare for a life in politics. After several months, the brothers moved in with a staunch Lutheran senator. Stanislaus became very ill and he wanted to receive Holy Communion before he died, but the Lutheran senator would not let the Eucharist in his house. Stanislaus prayed to St. Barbara, asking her to intercede with God so he could receive Viaticum. St. Barbara brought two angels to him to give him the Eucharist. He had a full recovery a couple of days later.

1st Grade Science: Physics Investigation




