Remember, all ladies of the parish are invited to participate in the Ladies Guild and its activities.

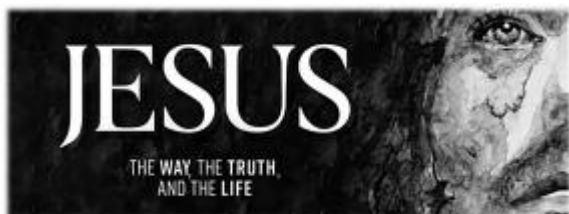
We have fun together, support each other and our families, and keep all members lifted in prayer.

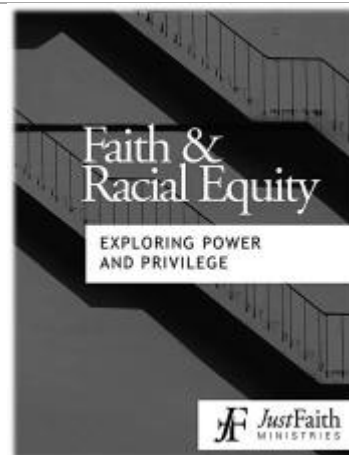

SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES WITHIN OUR FAMILY OF PARISHES

Prison Ministry

In addition to my service at the liturgy and my job as a Telecommunications Engineer for Ford Motor Credit, I also help run a Prison Ministry that operates in Detroit as part of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul.

What began as ministry inside prison walls, evolved to caring for those released from prison. Those who are released generally return home, which is metropolitan Detroit, and need assistance. When an inmate is paroled or released from an MDOC facility, he/she is given a bus ticket, two changes of clothes not appropriate for a job interview and a \$200 loan, which must be repaid on schedule, or it is considered a parole violation. They then return to prison.

We try to give a “hand up” in the form of some decent clothing, hygiene supplies, and bus tickets — nothing fancy, just the basics. Normally, when I make one of these appeals, we are looking for money or stuff. That is not the case this time. We are only looking for bodies!

We are seeking volunteers to help us spread the word about what we do. The volunteers we have in mind would not normally meet with our clients unless they want to. Instead, you would be meeting with management from the halfway houses who refer clients to us, as well as with churches and other charitable organizations who would support us to explain what we do. You could expect to spend 3 to 4 hours per month volunteering. We would train you thoroughly before sending you forth.

Franciscan Outreach at Transfiguration

Needy families from all over and beyond the Archdiocese of Detroit come seeking assistance and receive food from our program. It is staffed by volunteers and run on donations made to the program. It receives no direct financial support from the parish.

During 2020, more than 700 food packages were distributed each month. In November, in addition to the food bags, 230 families received turkeys and sides for a complete Thanksgiving meal. For Christmas, 137 families received a turkey and enough side dishes for a complete Christmas meal. Additionally, toys were provided to 254 boys and girl in those families, including 28 bicycles provided by a local Southfield business.

In total during 2020 we served 1756 families of which 1002 wear new clients. We gave out 701,450 pounds of food! We are always able to use donations and able bodied volunteers to help pack non-perishables food, check peopling, and assist those who cannot navigate the stairs, and help when there are large deliveries.

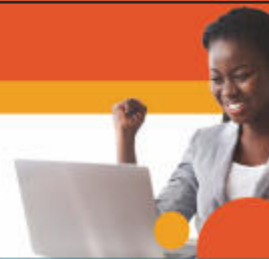
