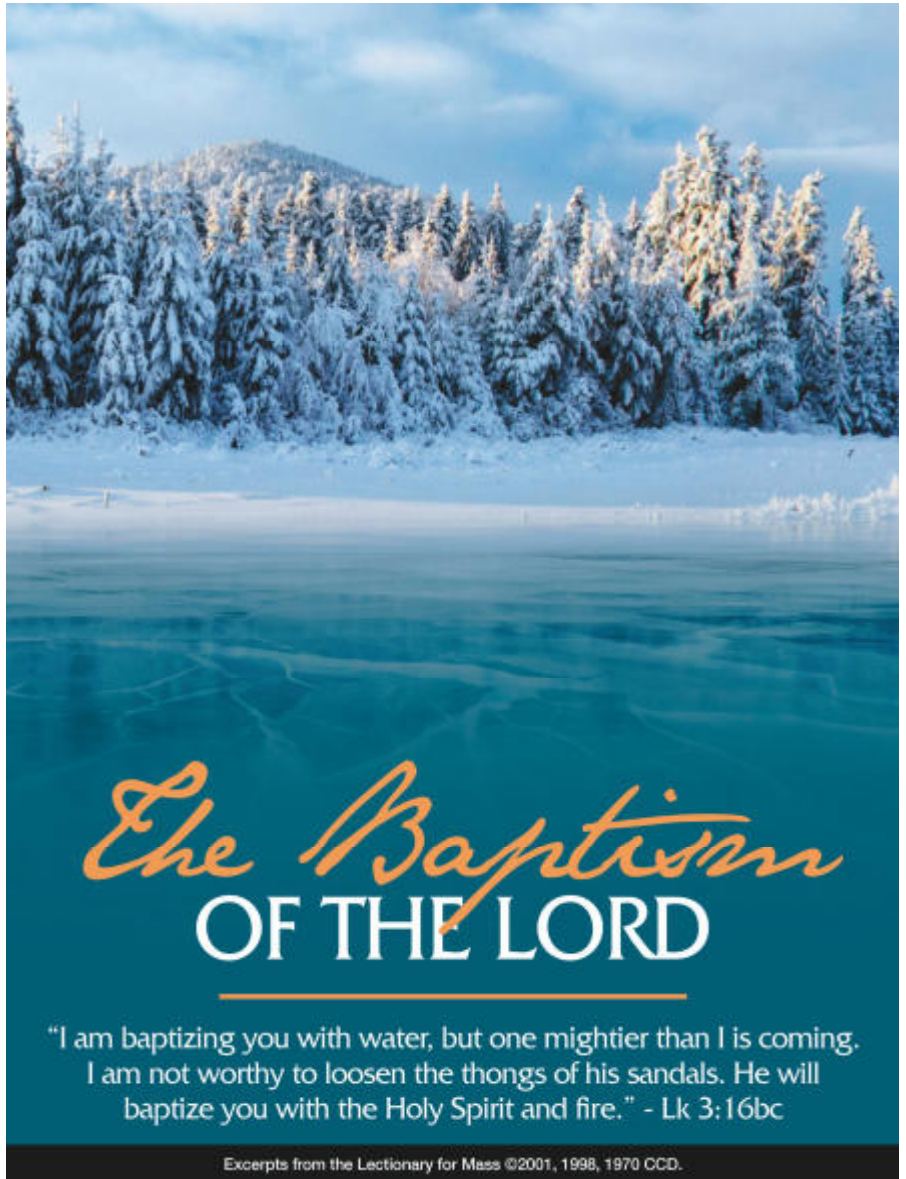

landed a job at a small television station, the kind of operation where everyone did everything. For the first couple of weeks, she shadowed one of the veteran reporters. Then the news director sent her to cover a city council hearing on a new bond issue — her first solo assignment. She met the crew and headed downtown. Now came her baptism in professional journalism.

His first year of teaching math and science to fourth and fifth graders was going well. He loved the kids and they loved him. Then one day a student had a meltdown — the poor kid was just not getting it and his frustration came out. So, the new teacher calmed him down and said to meet him after school. For more than an hour he went over the math problems, explaining and re-explaining, using example after example. Finally, the student's face lit up. "I think I get it now," he said. The teacher ran him through the math one more time to make sure. Yeah, he had it. Teacher and student high-fived each other in victory at this baptismal moment in each other's education.

They sat together, her hand squeezing his for dear life. They listened as the doctor explained the test results and the next steps. Every so often, they would look at each other, knowing that their forty-year marriage was about to enter a new baptism.

Scripture Reflection

Our lives are filled with "baptismal" moments when we are "submerged" in the waters of change, of discovery, of decision, of illness, of death. Baptism is not just a one-time ritual or milestone but a continuing experience of transformation in the spirit of Christ, the suffering servant of God, in the many "baptisms" we experience. Baptism is to take on a faith that becomes part of the very fabric of our lives, to embrace an identity in which God and the things of God become both our life's journey and destination.

Peoples of every nation, come and receive the immortality given in Baptism. . . . Do you wish to know how to do this? By water and the Holy Spirit. This is to say, by the water through which we are born again and given life, and by the Spirit who is the Comforter sent for your sake to make you a child of God.

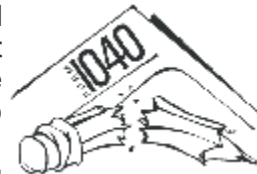

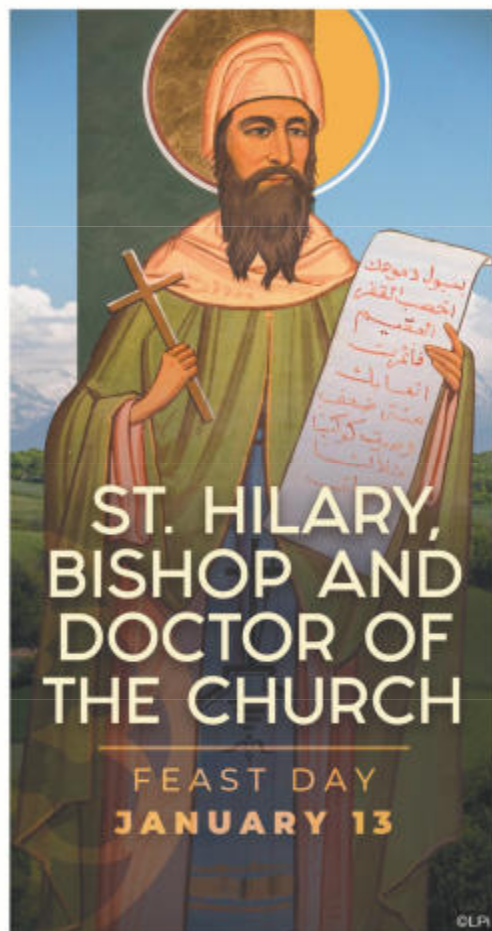

LIVE THE LITURGY

Inspiration for the week

Jesus stood in line with everyone else and was baptized. There is something incredibly humbling about how this must have played out. Then, God did something truly awesome and inspiring. Through a very gentle and simple action he let the world know about the special relationship He shares with Jesus. That's exactly what is so incredible about our baptisms as well! Through those holy waters God announces to the world the special place we also occupy in His heart. We no longer have to wonder about the purpose of our lives or struggle to find our way. We do not need to fumble around, tripping over ourselves and wondering why we are even here. The answer has been given. All we have to do is live out the vocation we have received, to live the Gospel in fidelity to our Creator. There is nothing to fear and worry has no place. Standing in line with other sinners, we have our anchor and God is very pleased.



SAINT OF THE WEEK

Born a pagan, St. Hilary (c. 315 – c. 367) studied philosophy and the meaning of life, eventually making his way through the bible. He became a convert and was appointed bishop of Poitiers in 353. Sometimes referred to as the Hammer of the Arians, St. Hilary defended the Nicene Creed against a popular heresy, Arianism. He was exiled to Phrygia for opposing Roman emperor Constantius II, who preferred the heresy which denies Christ's divinity. From Phrygia St. Hilary fought with his pen, zealously writing against the heresy.

Eventually he was allowed to return to Poitiers, but did so by a circuitous route, preaching against Arianism all the way. St. Hilary was likely the first writer of hymns in the West, his writings on the Trinity, Psalms and Gospel of Matthew survive today. St. Hilary was created Doctor of the Church, a title given to those who provided important contributions to theology and doctrine, in 1851 by Pope Pius IX.

Workshop Focuses on Pursuit of Justice

Dominican Saints Thomas Aquinas and Catherine of Siena both wrote extensively on the need for virtue in the life of a Christian. Pope Francis also focused on virtue in his letter, *Rejoice and Be Glad*.

Sister Geneal Kramer, OP, a Dominican Sister of Adrian, explores these insights and the ways we can internalize virtues in our life journey. Her presentation, *The Pursuit of Justice and Other Needed Virtues*, is offered via live stream from 1:30 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. EST on Tuesday, January 18, 2022. Sister Geneal, a retreat director and spiritual director, was a Professor of Practical Theology for St. Norbert College and Mount St. Mary Seminary in Cincinnati, Ohio.


