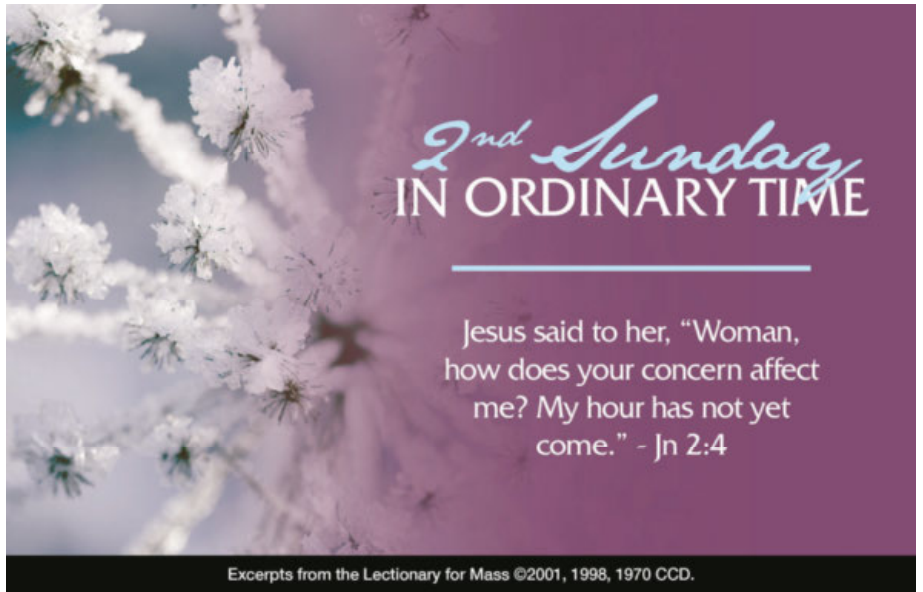

Second Sunday of Ordinary Time

“There was a wedding at Cana in Galilee . . .”

John 2: 1-11

Scripture Connection

Sigmund Freud wrote that there are four participants in every marriage: the woman, the man, the man she thinks she’s marrying, and the woman he thinks he’s marrying.

The realization that the person we married is far from perfect and a lot less “awesome” than we thought is the first crisis just about every marriage faces.

Rabbi Harold Kushner reflects on this conflict between fantasy and reality in his book ***Overcoming Life’s Disappointments***. Rabbi Kushner observes that it’s not only about the shortcomings of our mate — it’s about coming to terms with our own shortcomings, as well.

“I confess that I have a bias in favor of remaining married to the person you are married to. I believe that there were probably good reasons why you married the person you

did, and those reasons are still there, buried under the debris of mistakes and hurt feelings. (This does not apply to cases of physical abuse and criminal behavior, which no one should be asked to tolerate.) I believe (and I have seen this happen in so many families) that with a little digging, one can rediscover those feelings . . .

"And I believe that a little humility helps here as well, the ability to see where you may have contributed to the problem and the willingness to tolerate imperfections in your partner as you tolerate them in yourself. One marriage counselor I know would often say to each member of a couple he was advising, 'I've heard enough about your complaints about each other. Can you tell me something you've done that has contributed to your unhappiness and something you can do differently to make things better?'

"For what is love, our love for each other and God's love for us . . . if not the willingness to accept something less than perfection . . .? If you are mature enough to love someone, you are probably mature enough to love the person you are living with, even if he or she isn't the person you fell in love with and married."

Scripture Reflection

Good if imperfect marriages manifest the love of God at its most powerful: love that enables spouses to navigate together life's hard roads of fear, disappointment, heartache and illness. That Jesus performs his first "sign" at a wedding underscores the sacredness of marriage as the revelation of God's healing forgiveness and compassion in our midst. As ministers of the marriage sacrament, husbands and wives, in their love for one another, reveal to all of us the great love of God the Father made real for us in the person of his Christ, the Bridegroom

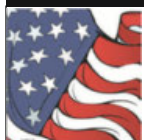
Year End Contribution Statements
