The following is a message from Archbishop Allen H. Vigneron to the people of the Archdiocese of Detroit:

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

While we are still several months away from election season, there are already several citizen-led ballot initiatives being proposed in Michigan. Of these initiatives, there is one of particular concern for Catholics and all people of good will: a proposal to include “a right to abortion” in our state constitution.

This initiative, led by Planned Parenthood and the American Civil Liberties Union, comes as the United States Supreme Court considers the future of *Roe v. Wade*. Should the court overturn that decision, laws in individual states will govern access to abortion. Current Michigan law bans abortion. Our opposition to this proposal, and indeed our opposition to abortion, is rooted in a clear witness to Jesus Christ and our understanding of the inherent, God-given dignity of all people, including the unborn. To sign this petition would be to actively participate in the promotion of the great evil of abortion.

The proposal is a symptom of a society that greatly devalues human life and views children as burdens. The Holy Spirit was clear through Synod 16 that “families today face unprecedented challenges, and for this reason our local Church must commit a major portion of her resources to supporting families and helping them live out their call to holiness” (*Unleash the Gospel*, Guidepost 7). In other words, when we reject this proposal, and any other efforts in support of abortion, we must simultaneously commit ourselves to creating and supporting clear and realistic alternatives that serve to protect and benefit both mother and child. It is critical that any pregnant woman considering abortion knows that she has better options available and, most importantly, that she knows the love of Christ as shared through the witness borne by you, me, and all Catholics.

In Him, life has triumphed over death. He will take all our efforts and transform them into steps toward accomplishing God’s will to restore creation.

Charity Garden

Spring is finally here, and the gardeners of the Charity Garden ministry are ready for another great growing season. Last year, we harvested about 4,900 pounds of produce (almost 2 ½ tons!) that was distributed to 9 different pantries throughout Macomb County. We are grateful that God and our church family have given us the talents and resources to help feed so many in need.



We were happy to see so many of you stop by our table at the Ministry Fair in March. Twelve wonderful new volunteers were able to join us for our first working session on April 30th. We look forward to working with them this season, and with any other interested parishioners who weren't able to join us that day.

Our garden works in partnership with the Horticulture Program at the L'Anse Creuse Public Schools Pankow Center. As part of that partnership, this year we will be hosting a Farm Day on Wednesday, June 8th. Two elementary school classes will be coming to tour the Garden and learn about how food crops are grown.

If you would like to learn more about our garden, or just see what it takes to produce 2 tons of food, join us for a Garden Walk on July 10th (rain date: July 17th) from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Don't like getting your hands dirty, but still want to help? Watering cans and bottled water are at the top of our wish list this year. (The bottled water is for the workers, not the plants!)

- Stethoscopes
- Blood Pressure machines
- Surgical tape, gauze patches and rolls
- Tourniquets
- Pain relievers like Aleve, Advil, Ibuprofen and the like, large bottles
- Neosporin, antiseptic salve, surgical gloves men's and women's
- Hand Warmers
- MRE (FIELD FOOD, k-Rations) from Amazon
- Due to the volume of toiletries and feminine hygiene products donated, there is no current collection of these items at the Civic Center. We will only be collecting the above medical supplies.

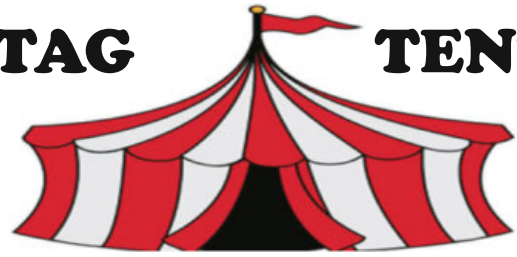

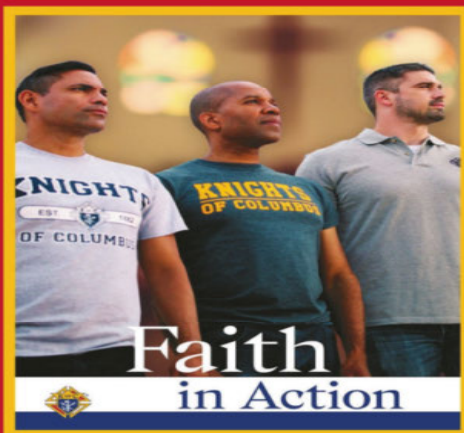

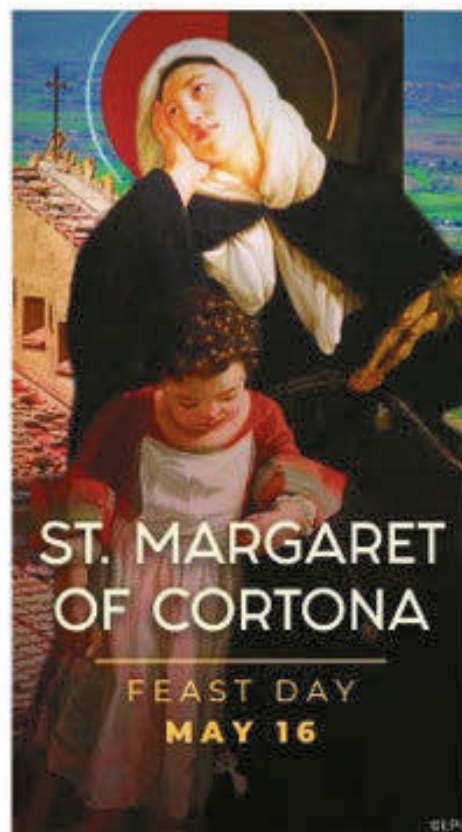

ST. MARGARET OF CORTONA

FEAST DAY
MAY 16

SAINT OF THE WEEK

Though St. Margaret of Cortona (1247 – 1297) is today known as being an incredibly pious Catholic, she didn't start out that way. Born into a farming family in Laviano, Tuscany, her mother died when St. Margaret was seven. Her father remarried, but life with her stepmother was so difficult that St. Margaret moved out of the home and instead chose to live with a man named Arsenio, though they weren't married. They had been living together for nine years when she gave birth to a son. Knowing in her heart that this wasn't the life that God intended for her to have, she prayed for purity.

One day while waiting for Arsenio, his dog led her into the forest where she found Arsenio murdered. So shocked was St. Margaret that she fell into a life of penance. She and her son returned to Laviano, but still found her stepmother to be as unwelcoming as ever. They then went to Cortona, and eventually her son became a friar.

Three years after her conversion, St. Margaret followed in her son's footsteps and became a Franciscan tertiary. During her life, St. Margaret established a hospital and founded a congregation of tertiary sisters. She was canonized in 1728.
