

Fifth Sunday of Lent

Jesus cried out in a loud voice, "Lazarus, come out!" The dead man came out, tied hand and food with burial bands, and his face wrapped in a cloth. "Untie him and let him go."

John 11: 1-45

Scripture Connection

As was the case in John's account of the healing of the man born blind (last Sunday's Gospel), the raising of Lazarus is more than just a sign of Jesus' love and compassion. Each of the seven miracles that John includes in his Gospel ("the Book of Signs," as this section of John's Gospel is titled) is dramatized by the evangelist to underscore some dimension of the redemptive nature of Jesus' work. Today's Gospel, the climactic sign in John's Gospel, is presented in five distinct, self-contained scenes: Jesus receiving the news of Lazarus' death, the disciples' protesting Jesus' return to Judea, Martha's pleading with Jesus, Jesus' emotional arrival at the tomb, and the miraculous raising of Lazarus.

The raising of Lazarus is clearly intended by John to demonstrate Jesus' power over life and death. The raising of Lazarus plays like a rehearsal for the events next week's liturgies will celebrate.

Scripture Reflection

As Jesus called out to Lazarus to be untied from the wrappings of the dead and to be free to live once again, so we are called to be free from those things that keep us too busy from loving and being loved.

Resurrection is an attitude, a perspective that finds hope in the hardest times and uncovers life among the ruined, that reveals light in the darkest night. To each one of us belongs Jesus' work of resurrection at Lazarus's tomb: to help others free themselves from their tombs of dark hopelessness and the fear and sadness that bind them.



GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

In today's Gospel, we see so clearly the fully human nature of Jesus even in the midst of him revealing his divine nature in raising Lazarus from the dead. On hearing that his friend Lazarus had died, Jesus "wept," and he became "perturbed and deeply troubled." We see his love for Martha and Mary, and the freedom he gives them to love him fully in return, and to expect things of him. Each of them confronts Jesus, exasperated: Had you come earlier, our brother would not have died! Yet in the same breath, they express their faith that Jesus is the resurrection and the life. As we continue our Lenten journey, we can rest assured that Jesus is never far from us and that he understands our human longings, struggles and pain. Like Martha and Mary, we can place our faith in Jesus here, now and for eternity.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

The raising of Lazarus foreshadows Christ's death and resurrection and reminds us of God's enduring power over death. That can, at times, seem a small comfort as we confront our own mortality or mourn the loss of those dear to us. Yet, just as Jesus showed his love for Lazarus, Martha and Mary, we, too, can extend our love and support for others in their grief. We can show our love through our simple presence, a thoughtful card or an offer to pray for the deceased person and their family. In these ways, we can strengthen our own faith and that of others. As we hear in today's Gospel, "Now many of the Jews who had come to Mary and seen what he had done began to believe in him."

ACTION As we grow closer to Holy Week, now is a good time to participate in the sacrament of reconciliation. Has it been a while? The U.S. Bishops provide a helpful guide on their website: usccb.org.
