Of winning Victory in these things.

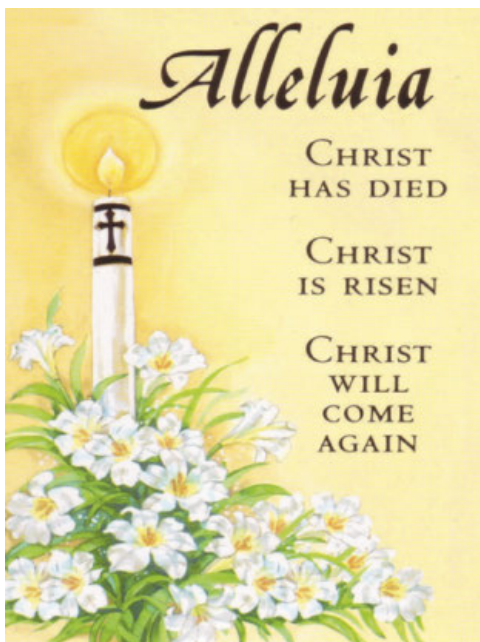
My face is set like flint,

## Music Corner

**Easter / Liturgy:** Just a bit of commentary about the beauty and love in our Roman Catholic music and heritage on Easter—the Sequence "**Victimae Paschali Laudes**" aka "**The Easter Sequence**" located on page 1065 in the Blue Gather III Hymnals (in English: "Praise To The Passover Victim")—this has been chanted for centuries in Latin for the Roman Rite Easter Liturgy is a medieval biblically-based Latin poetic-liturgical hymn for meditation.

It is an obligatory element of Easter Sunday Mass. This sequence is one of only four sequences continued/preserved after the Council of Trent (including the other three: "Veni Sancti Spiritus" at Pentecost, "Lauda Sion" for Corpus Christi, and "Dies Irae" for the Requiem mass All Souls), and is still used in Liturgies today, sung just before the gospel acclamation, and also is sung every day from Easter Sunday through the Easter Octave.

This chant narrates the death and life within a struggle—where Christ the Paschal Victim in his victory over death reconciles us all back to the Father. The chant also narrates Mary Magdalene's finding the empty tomb of the Risen Christ and finding the clothes that covered his head and limbs—she then proclaims "Christ, my hope has arisen!" The sequence ends affirming Christ's resurrection—to be true in large part based on St. Mary Magdalene's testimony—the Latin verb "scire" quite strong as to referring to the highest level of human "knowing" then the sequence ends with Christ the Victor, King / victor Rex, show us mercy.

Cardinal Newman understood the sensitivity to be "deep in history"—and we also preserve our history—our precious treasures of Gregorian Chants "...diligently and to impart it generously to the Christian people...and great care should be taken that it be performed properly, worthily, and reverently." (adapted from encyclical *Musicae Sacrae* 1955)

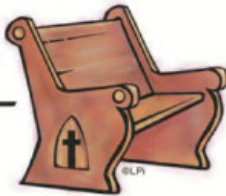

Each day, approximately 50-60 women & children receive a bagged breakfast and lunch meal, and dinner meals are provided by seven families from St. Hubert Church. Some families bring their own people to serve the meals and cleanup, but there may be a day or so where we may need additional assistance with serving and cleanup. We arrive at the Shelter at approximately 4:30 p.m. and finish around 8:30 p.m.

There will be a sign-up sheet in the back of Church for anyone interested in volunteering during our week to serve dinner and/or shop for additional groceries and supplies. All volunteers must have a Background Check Form completed and on file at the Rectory along with a Protecting God's Children certificate on file.

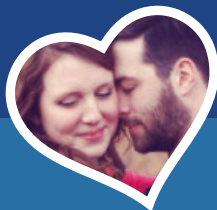
