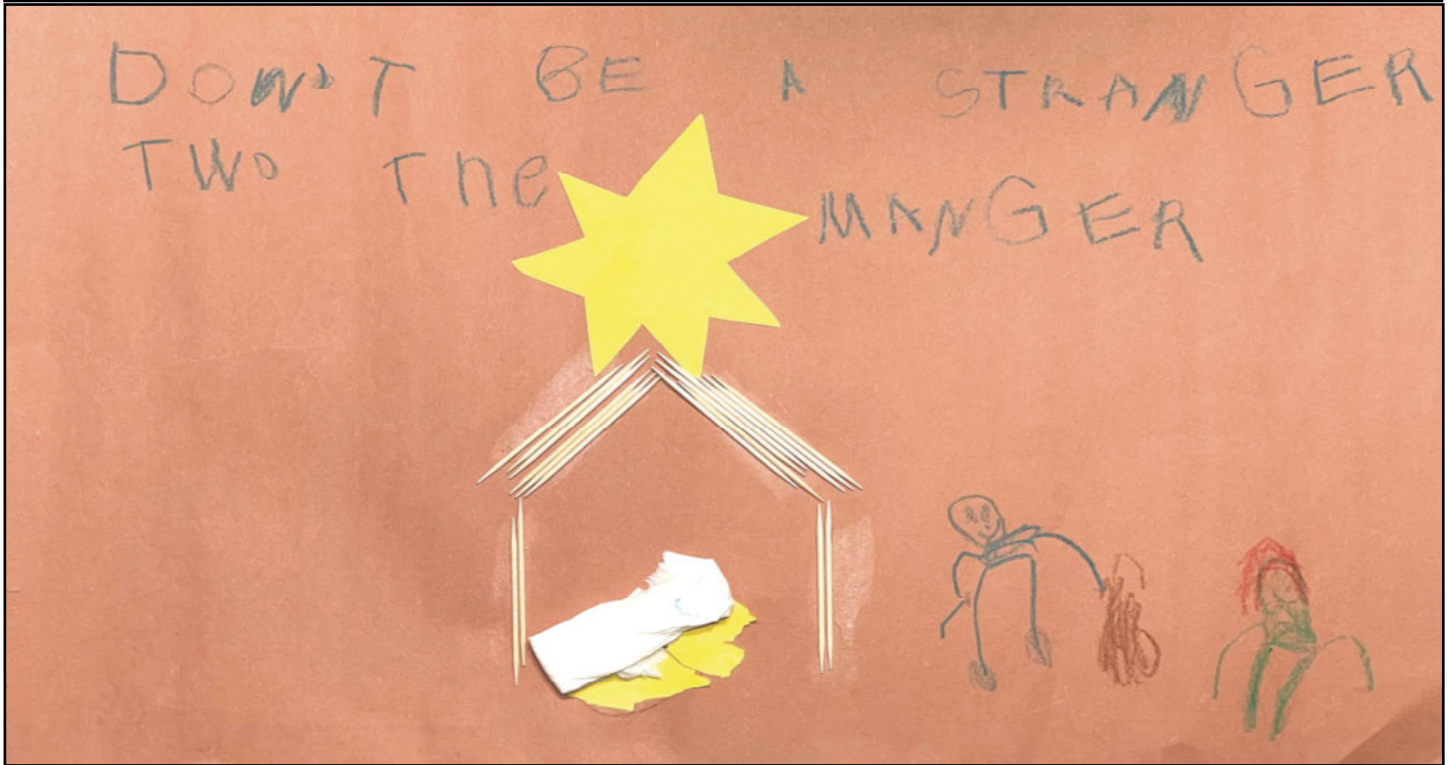
The choir is open to all ages, even school age students, if they have the interest and determination to participate. As always, we need male singers and altos.

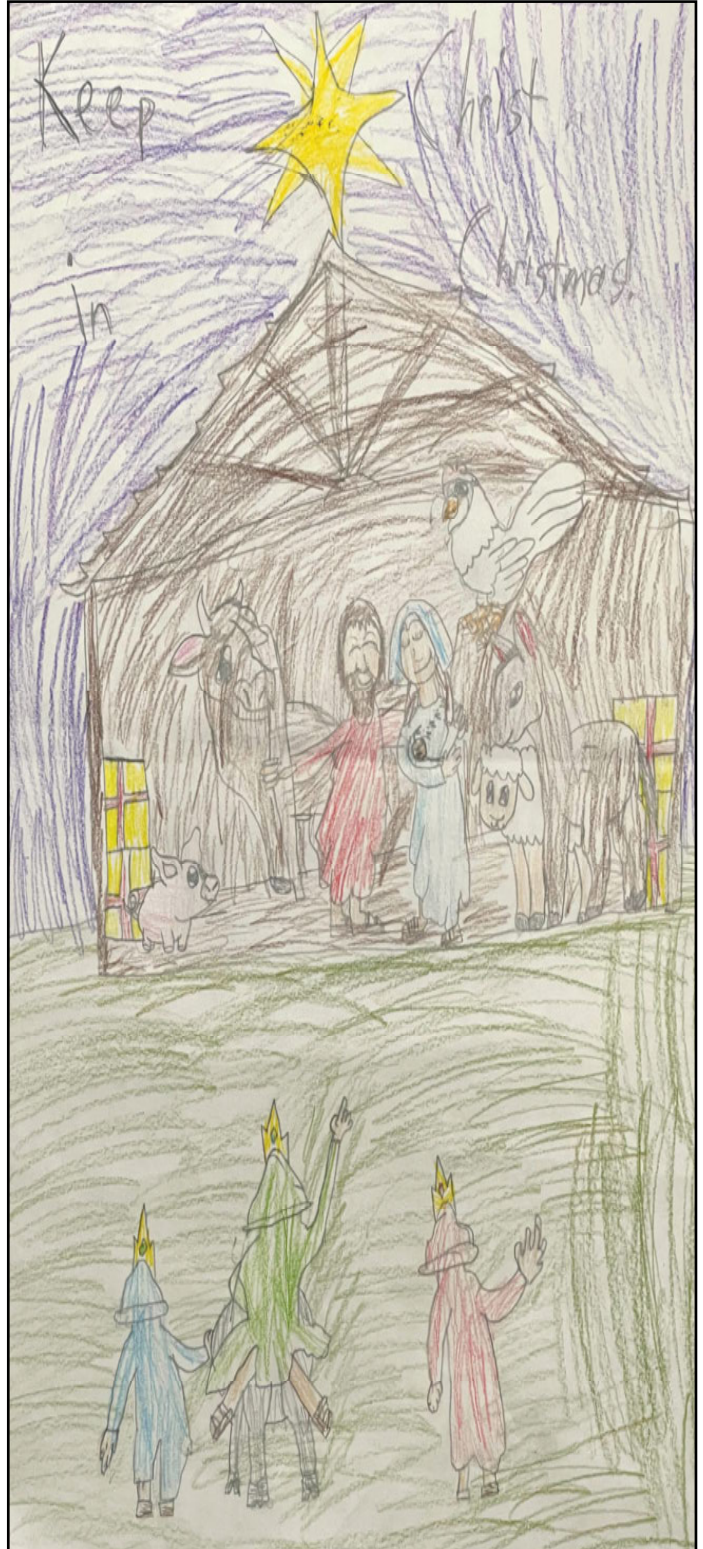

McCormick Academy Gym in Port Huron
registration begins at 12 noon.

The Knights of Columbus Free Throw
Championship is open to all boys & girls. Age
eligibility is determined by the age of the contestant
as of January 1, 2022. Proof of age is required.
High school-age athletes are advised to check with
their school athletic directors regarding possible
eligibility conflicts.

Each youngster may compete in only one council
competition. Winners will progress to the district,
regional and state level competition. International
champions are chosen on the basis of state level
results.

Boys & Girls ages 9, 10 and 11 use a women's
regulation-size basketball and shoot from a 12-foot
line at a 10-foot-high basket.

Girls ages 12, 13 and 14 use a women's
regulation-size basketball and shoot from a regulation
foul line 15 feet from a 10-foot-high basket.

Boys ages 12, 13 and 14 use a men's regulation-size
basketball and shoot from a regulation foul line
15 feet from a 10-foot-high basket.

Normal rules of basketball regarding free throws
apply for all levels of competition.
Free-throw violations include stepping over the line
prior to the ball reaching the rim or shots rebounding
off the "out of bounds" basket support and
equipment.

Each contestant receives three warm-up tosses
followed by 15 consecutive free-throw attempts from
the appropriate age-designation foul line.

Commemorative Brick Pavers

PAVER SALES

After additional discussions with our local engraver and the real possibility that lead times could stretch out well into the next year or longer, I pulled all the paver orders and materials from the vendor.

However, GOOD NEWS!!

I was able to find an engraver in Mt. Clemens who seemed eager to work with us. That being said, I brought the previously listed back orders to them for processing. I am happy to report that I have already picked up the completed pavers. So for those who have been awaiting completion of your order, they are here.

We are back in business!

I would like to pass on some information that would helpful for those of you who still want to order commemorative pavers. First and foremost.....**We are still selling pavers!** If you look at the number of blank pavers in the walkway, you can see that we will be able to sell them well into the future. So, those of you who were concerned that we will not be can now breathe easier.

I did pursue the idea of normal lead times for future reference. They responded by saying that this is their slower time of the year and that lead times are typically about 4 weeks or maybe sooner. That from my experience is very good. However, lead times lengthen as April and May come around as their other core business orders increases significantly. So, if you have been thinking of ordering 1 or more pavers, now may be the more preferable time to do it.

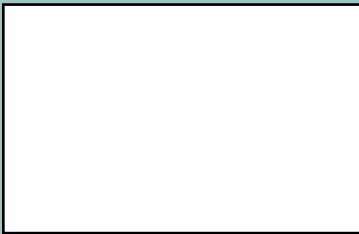

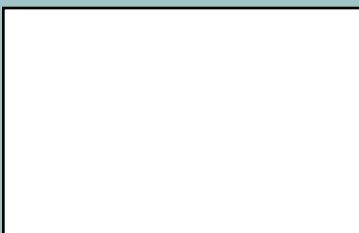
