## From the Desk of Father Kelm

HOMILY: 6<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ord. Time, Cycle B,  
2/13 & 14/2021



Readings: Leviticus 13:1-2, 44-46 1 Corinthians 10:31-11:1 Mark 1:40-45

OPENER: St. Augustine: “God has deemed it better to bring good out of evil than not to permit evil at all.”

In our reading from Leviticus, we are presented with the directive that “diagnosed” lepers shall dwell apart from the rest of the community to protect public health, in the spirit of promoting the “common good”. Borrowing from last week’s theme, lepers had to resign themselves to living out God’s will for them. What a tough row to hoe...

This Gospel miracle is curious in that the leper’s bold request implies a strong faith in Jesus’ power and compassionate will for a *cleansing* – not merely a healing. Jesus touches the leper in a shocking move, and wills the cleansing, which occurs immediately. “Then warning him sternly, he dismissed him at once.” St. Mark then records Jesus speaking to the former leper: “mums the word”, go show yourself to the priest, etc. So, who did Jesus just sternly address?! It doesn’t seem to be the former leper! A modern Scripture scholar, Mary Healy, wrote that at that moment, Jesus exorcised a demon that was afflicting the man causing the leprosy, just as in Job’s case several centuries earlier. She also notes that Jesus and the leper traded places, with Jesus needing to remain outside of towns in deserted places – because His arrival caused mob scenes.

In 1 Cor 10, St. Paul is explaining how he tries to please everyone in every way, disregarding his own preferences, but concerned about the needs of others for their salvation. In other words, Paul is looking out for the common good of the local Christian community, wherever he may be, in order to foster its growth.

Jesus showed His concern for the common good by cleansing the leper, thereby returning him to his family to love and support them. Such “hard luck” cases are a real testimony to the power of marital love to endure. Truly a charitable deed that fostered familial, as well as societal growth.

Recognize the “prince of darkness’s” power in the world before Calvary and the flourishing of the Christian Church, and our bloodless re-enactment of Calvary – The Mass. Generally, historically speaking, when the Church flourished, peace flourished, but when people grew lax, evil resumed its show of strength. Thus, will it be until the of time. Look around us! ...and recall what St. Paul wrote to the Corinthians in his first letter (1 Cor 9:24) concerning runners in the games: “run so as to win!”.

## Fr. Kevin’s Corner

### Grateful Hearts

When thirty - eight - year - old Elizabeth Ann Bartlett, an associate professor of political science at the University of Minnesota, and a vibrant wife and mother was stricken with heart problems, she was devastated.

Consumed with resentment at all she had lost, including hopes for a long and carefree life with her family, she realized she would need to find the blessings in her illness to survive.

“As the tenuousness of my life sank in, I came to see each day as a gift,” she says. She discovered an interweaving of grace and gratitude, and found that a daily appreciation of the ordinary gifts grants us grace.

Bartlett has since received a new heart through a successful transplant operation. “I think the real gift I received in receiving the new heart is the gift of knowing gratitude in such a deep and profound way.” She reflects, “Little did I know how much receiving a new physical heart would also transform my spiritual heart.”
